I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

18 January 2020, 6:00 PM

Since 8:00 AM this morning, Taal Volcano's activity has been generally characterized by weak emission of steam-laden plumes 500 to 800 meters high from the Main Crater that drifted to the general southwest. A total of 2 discrete weak ash explosions were observed.

Latest sulfur dioxide (SO2) emission was measured at an average of 1,442 tonnes/day today at 5:00 PM.

Alert Level 4 still remains in effect over Taal Volcano. This means that hazardous explosive eruption is possible within hours to days. DOST-PHIVOLCS strongly reiterates total evacuation of Taal Volcano Island and high-risk areas as identified in the hazard maps within the 14-km radius from Taal Main Crater and along the Pansipit River Valley where fissuring has been observed. Residents around Taal Volcano are advised to guard against the effects of heavy and prolonged ashfall. Civil aviation authorities must advise pilots to avoid the airspace around Taal Volcano as airborne ash and ballistic fragments from the eruption column pose hazards to aircraft. DOSTPHIVOLCS is continually monitoring the eruption and will update all stakeholders of further developments.

If the eruption column remains at **5 km** or below, the ash plumes will be drifted to the municipalities south and southwest of Taal Volcano. However, if a major eruption occurs within the forecast period and the column exceeds **5 km**, ash plumes will also be drifted over the **eastern** and **northeastern** portions of Batangas and **Laguna**.

II. EFFECTS

A. Affected Population

- A total <u>22,472 families / 96,061 persons</u> were affected in the Batangas, Laguna, and Cavite. Of which, a total of <u>16,174 families / 70,413 persons</u> are taking temporary shelter in <u>300 evacuation centers</u>
- The LGUs of Alitagtag, Balayan, Batangas City, Bauan, Calatagan, Lian, Lipa, Malvar, Nasugbu, Rosario, San Jose, San Luis, San Pascual, Santa Teresita, Sto. Tomas, and Tuy in Batangas; Alfonso, Indang, Maragondon, Mendez (MENDEZ-NUÑEZ), Tagaytay City, and Ternate in Cavite; Cabuyao and City of Calamba in Laguna; and Candelaria, Dolores, Gumaca, Perez, San Antonio, Sariaya, and Tiaong in Quezon hosted IDPs from affected municipalities.

B. Status of Lifelines

Roads

- To this date, a total of <u>7 road sections</u> (previous report: 6) were reported not passable/closed. Roads are currently on lockdown as safety precautions for the community.

- b. At 8:54 AM, TOWSOL personnel onboard 1 KM450 assisted in the distribution of relief goods (200 sacks rice, assorted clothing and water) at Lemery Municipal Hall to Brgy Dalipit, Alitagtag, Batangas.
- c. At 9:00 AM, JTG EX-O attended the media brief of Batangas Governor at Dalubhasaan Bldg, Provincial Sports Complex ICOW updates on the Taal Volcano Operations.
- d. At 9:40 AM, 5FAB, AAR personnel onboard 1 M35 truck of AETDC departed from JTG Taal, FAB, Lipa City, Batangas to Tuy and Sta Teresita, Batangas to haul relief goods.
- e. At 9:45 AM, 1 team of 22DRC conducted hauling of evacuees from PUP Sto. Tomas, Batangas to Brgy. San Bartolome, Sto. Tomas, Batangas.
- f. At 10:00 AM, the Executive Director of Facility Security in Solaire Resorts and Casino coordinated with 202Bde, JTG Deputy Commander

- regarding the planned relief operation of Solaire Resorts and Casino to the affected areas of Taal Volcano eruption.
- g. At 10:05 AM, 2 5-tonner truck with assorted relief goods from CMOR, PA arrived at JTG Taal, FAB, Lipa City, Batangas.
- h. At 12:20 PM, 2 EP assisted the MDRRMO for the distribution of relief goods around the Municipality of Alitagtag.
- i. At 1:45 PM, JTG EX-O attended a conference of the IMT's Operations and Response Cluster at Incident Command Post, Dalubhasaan Bldg, Provincial Sports Complex. Topics discussed: identifying of ways on how to smoothen the coordination of all cluster members, lockdown parameters and discrepancy of data being published.
- j. At 2:45 PM, 1 Officer and 12 EP of PN assisted on the unloading of assorted relief goods (4 bundles of bottled water, 1 box of towel, 3 boxes of assorted foods, one box of bread).
- k. At 2:50 PM, 1 Officer and 12 EP of NTU hauled relief goods/items (80 packs of pillow and pillow cases, 10 cases of drinking water with 24 bottles per case, 3 boxes of canned sardines) at Cuenca Evacuation Center, Cuenca Central School, Batangas for distribution to more or less 755 evacuees in the area.
- I. At 3:30, 1 officer and 12 EP of PN hauled assorted items such as 4 thermos of water, 200 packs of relief goods, 1 box of Nebulizer kit, 1 box of Salbutamol Sulfate (Asthma Gone), 1 box of safeguard, 1 box of Carbocistene, and 6 boxes of rice from HMC Ambulance Paramedics Qatar at Cuenca, Batangas City.
- m. At 9:00 PM, 202Bde, 2ID and HPA (Landers) conducted distribution of relief goods to different evacuation centers at Bauan, Batangas that benefited a total of 4,876 evacuees.

Activated all available evacuation centers in adjacent municipalities and barangays in the Province of Batangas and facilitated the evacuation procedure.
