### **Situational Report No. 11 re Taal Volcano Eruption**

#### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW**

**15 January 2020, 5:00 PM**

Taal Volcano's eruption has been characterized by continuous magmatic and hydrovolcanic activity that generated 700-meter tall dark gray steam-laden plumes that drifted to the general southwest.

In addition to the previously identified fissures in Lemery (Sinisian, Mahabang Dahilig, Dayapan, Palanas, Sangalang, Poblacion, Mataas na Bayan), Agoncillo (Pansipit, Bilibinwang), Talisay (Poblacion 1, Poblacion 2, Poblacion 3, Poblacion 5), and San Nicolas (Poblacion), new fissures were observed in Sambal Ibaba, Lemery. Drying up of portions of Pansipit River has also been observed. Furthermore, newly acquired satellite images would show that the Main Crater Lake (MCL) has been drained and new vent craters have been formed inside the Main Crater and on the north flank of the volcano.

Alert Level 4 still remains in effect over Taal Volcano. This means that hazardous explosive eruption is possible within hours to days. DOST-PHIVOLCS strongly reiterates total evacuation of Taal Volcano Island and high-risk areas as identified in the hazard maps within the 14-km radius from Taal Main Crater and along the Pansipit River Valley where fissuring has been observed. Residents around Taal Volcano are advised to guard against the effects of heavy and prolonged ashfall. Civil aviation authorities must advise pilots to avoid the airspace around Taal Volcano as airborne ash and ballistic fragments from the eruption column pose hazards to aircraft. DOST-PHIVOLCS is continually monitoring the eruption and will update all stakeholders of further developments.

A total of **520 volcanic earthquakes** were recorded in Taal region as of **4:00 PM**. Of which, **169 were felt**, ranging from **Magnitude 1.2 – 4.1** and Intensity of **I – V**.

If the eruption column remains at **7 km** or below, the ash plumes will be drifted to the municipalities **west and southwest** of Taal Volcano. However, if a major eruption occurs within the forecast period and the column exceeds **7 km**, ash plumes will also be drifted over the **eastern** and southeastern portions of Batangas and some municipalities of Quezon, Mindoro, and Marinduque.

**II. EFFECTS****A. Affected Population**

- A total **12,486 families / 53,019 persons** were affected in the Batangas and Cavite. Of which, a total of **10,000 families / 43,681 persons** are taking temporary shelter in **217 evacuation centers**.
- The LGUs of Alitagtag, Balayan, Batangas City, Bauan, Calaca, Calatagan, Lian, San Pascual, Sto. Tomas, and Tuy in Batangas, and Alfonso and Tagaytay City in Cavite hosted IDPs from affected municipalities.

- c. Conducted a Sub-Committee on Natural Disaster meeting at NHQ PNP Command Center and provided security coverage during the visit of PRRD in Batangas City on 14 January 2020, 9:00 AM and 6:15 PM respectively.
- d. Distributed relief goods to the evacuees in Batangas.

- Advise the LGU to coordinate with all barangays within AOR regarding the influx of evacuees from affected LGUs for security monitoring purposes.
- Coordinate with the LGU relative to the monitoring of respiratory related illnesses triggered by ash inhalation for medical assistance.
- Coordinate with the LGUs and submitted the list and number of vehicles (6x6 trucks), breathing apparatus, and water purifiers which the LGUs can commit for possible deployment to affected LGUs in CALABARZON for evacuation assistance purposes.
- Coordinate with the LGU relative to the assistance that can be extended by the NCR to affected LGUs in CALABARZON.

#### **DILG Field Office**

Coordinated with respective LGUs re Memorandum on Taal Volcano updates based from the conducted PDRA meeting of MMDRRMC.

#### **LGUs of NCR**

- Conducted emergency DRRM Council meetings to discuss the situation and actions taken by the LGUs.
- Activated EOCs of the 17 NCR LGUs on a 24-hour operations to monitor the situation.
- Ensured all health centers are open to accommodate respiratory related illnesses due to ashfall effects.
- Distributed masks to all duty personnel in all health centers.

#### **BFP – NCR**

Placed 31 personnel and 4 Fire EMS on standby.

#### **PNP – NCR**

- On Red Alert status from 12 to 14 January 2020.
- Placed 27 personnel (SAR TEAM) on standby.

Distributed face masks to CDRRMC members and to frontline service providers of CENRO and TPMO.
