I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

A. Volcanic Earthquake

The Taal Volcano Network (TVN) plotted a total of 1,990 volcanic earthquakes as of 04 February 2020, 2:00 AM.

II. EFFECTS

A. Affected Population

- A total <u>129,010 families / 482,925 persons</u> were affected in the Provinces of Batangas, Quezon, Laguna, and Cavite.
- Of which, a total of <u>6,830 families / 23,915 persons</u> are taking temporary shelter in <u>152 evacuation centers</u> while <u>60,373 families / 224,188 persons</u> are served outside ECs.
- The LGUs of Alitagtag, Balayan, Balete, Batangas City, Bauan, Calaca, Calatagan, Ibaan, Lian, Lipa City, Lobo, Malvar, Nasugbu, Padre Garcia, Rosario, San Jose, San Luis, San Pascual, Santa Teresita, Sto.
