I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

A. Volcanic Earthquake

15 January 2020

A total of **466 volcanic earthquakes** were recorded in Taal region as of **8:00 AM**. Of which, 156 were felt, ranging from **Magnitude 1.5 – 3.8** and Intensity of **I – V**.

B. Special Weather Forecast for Taal Volcano (14 January 2020, 5:00 PM – 15 January 2020, 5:00 PM)

Quezon Province will experience cloudy skies with light rains while Metro Manila, Cavite, Laguna, and Rizal will experience partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains. Batangas will experience cloudy skies with isolated rains.

Light to strong winds coming from the northeast will prevail and the coastal waters will be slight to rough.

If the eruption column remains at 3 km or below, the ash plumes will be drifted to the municipalities southwest of Taal Volcano. However, if a major eruption occurs within the forecast period and the column exceeds 3 km, ash plumes will be drifted over south-eastern portion of Batangas and some municipalities of Quezon, Mindoro, and Marinduque.

II. EFFECTS

A. Affected Population

A total **12,486 families / 53,019 persons** were affected in the Batangas and Cavite. Of which, a total of **10,000 families / 43,681 persons** are taking

temporary shelter in **217 evacuation centers**. Some of LGUs in the Provinces of Batangas, Cavite, and Laguna hosted IDPs from affected municipalities.

3. Armed Forces of the Philippines (AFP)

13 January 2020

- At 2:00 PM, one squad, 2SigBn from H2ID, Camp Capinpin, Tanay, Rizal proceeded to Talisay, Batangas as additional HADR Team and transport 10 drums (2,000L) of POL thereat.
- At 12:39 AM, 1 KM250 and 4 5-Toner Truck from 4FSSU, PA arrived at Talisay, Batangas for additional manpower and transportation assistance.
- At 12:38 AM 4FSSU, ASCOM, PA arrived at Laurel Municipal Hall with 3 8-Toner Trucks and 2 6-Toner Truck for additional manpower and transportation assistance.
- At 1:00 AM 0/6 PA from 1IB arrived at Talisay Municipal Building, Talisay, Batangas for additional manpower and transportation assistance.
- At 12:45 AM, 0/14 personnel led by PAF arrived at MDRRMO, Mataas na Kahoy and Municipality of Balete both are all manageable as per MDRRMO.
- HADR Platoon of 2ID conducted the first hauling of affected residents due to the sudden eruption of Taal Volcano at Barangay Banga, Talisay, Batangas. Affected residents were evacuated to Poblacion 3, Sto. Tomas, Batangas and arrived thereat at 3:00 AM on same day. Likewise, the HADR

teams of 2SBn arrived at Talisay, Batangas on 13 January 2020. 5:00 AM and had linked up with the HADR Platoon 2ID.

- g. At 6:00 AM the HADR Platoon of 2ID and 2SBn conducted the 2nd hauling of affected residents of Talisay, Batangas and which were evacuated to Poblacion 3, Sto. Tomas, Batangas.
- h. At 1:10 AM, 4FSSU arrived at the North Central School, Sto. Tomas, Batangas with around 2000 evacuees from Talisay. Likewise, 1 platoon of SEBn onboard 5 Military trucks of ASCOM and arrived at the Municipality of Laurel, Batangas. While, 2 Super Huey #122 and #622 departed at HTOG4 to conduct Aerial Survey/Aerial Inspection.
- i. At 12:15 PM, 1 Fire Team conducted transportation assistance to the residence of Laurel, Batangas going to Ibaan, Sports Center, Batangas.
- j. At 8:05 AM, 1 Fire Team conducted transportation assistance to the residence of Brgy. Zone 8, Talisay, Batangas going to PUP University, Sto. Thomas, Batangas.
- k. At 9:00 AM, 2 Fire Teams conducted transportation assistance to the residence of Talisay, Batangas.
- l. At 3:30 PM signal platoon under from ICP, Talisay, Batangas proceeded to San Fernando Air Base, Lipa City to establish communication facility thereat to provide communication support.
- m. At 1:00 PM, SOLCO COC, Radio room contacted the CEIS Team PA at Brgy. Talisay, Batangas.
- n. One signal platoon of 2nd signal Battalion established communication facilities (ICP) at Talisay Batangas providing CEIS support to the HADR operations.
- o. At 8:00 – 10:00 AM, ACOMSOLCOM with triad, 2ID triad and Bde Cmdr, 202Bde, attended the RDRRMC CALABARZON meeting at Tagaytay Convention Center, Tagaytay City ICOW the Taal Volcano Eruption.
- p. At 11:00 – 12:00 NN, ACOMSOLCOM and SOLCOM TRIAD Staff conducted site visitation at Talisay Batangas and also supervise the ongoing evacuation threat.
- q. At 5:30 AM – 5:20 PM, ACOMSOLCOM with SOLCOM TRIAD Staff, 2ID TRIAD and Cmdr 202Bde attended the Taal Volcano Eruption Operation Coordination meeting at Fernando Airbase, Lipa City, Batangas with different Govt agencies of Region CALABARZON.
- r. Attended Emergency Response Cluster Meeting for Taal Volcano Eruption at OCD MIMAROPA Regional Office, PEO Compound, Kumintang Ilaya, Batangas City attended by PAF.
