THE WESTERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON AND THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF NORTHEASTERN MINDANAO (Ilocos Norte, Ilocos Sur, Eastern Coast of Dinagat Islands (eastern Coasts of Loreto and Tubajon, and Cagdianao), eastern Coast of Surigao Del Norte (San Benito, Sta. Monica, Burgos, San Isidro, Pilar, Gen. Luna, Dapa, and eastern Coast of Socorro), and Surigao Del Sur)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains	41-52 / 22-28	Rough	2.5 - 3.5
