I. Fire Incident at Sitio Sto. Niño, Brgy. Suba, Cebu City - Region VII

A. Situation Overview (Chronological Events)

27 February 2020

On or about 07:05 PM, a fire incident Sitio Sto. Niño, Brgy. Suba, Cebu City was reported to Cebu Fire Station. All Cebu City Fire Sub stations, North & South sectors Fire Volunteer of Cebu City & neighboring cities, municipalities fire stations responded to the reported fire alarm and upon arrival at the fire scene they conducted firefighting operation and combat the outraging fire which rapidly spread and consumes multiple houses.

Details regarding the cause of the incidents is still under investigation.

B. Effects

Affected Population

2,851 persons or an equivalent of 638 families were displaced

Damage Houses

A total of 311 houses were affected, 271 of which were totally damaged

Cost of Damage

An estimated total cost of Php 1,500,000.00

C. Actions Taken

OCD CAR

 Coordinated with Bureau of Fire Protection – Region VII (BFP) relative to the incident

BFP CAR, BFP Provincial Office, and FS Kibungan

- Duty personnel continuously responded to the forest fire for fire suppression and containment activities.
- FS Officers conducted suppression along roads.
- Conducted interviews, meetings, and investigations.
- Supported firefighting activities, logistics, reporting, and investigations.

Volunteers and Local Residents

 Continuously supported BFP CAR and FS Kibungan in fire suppression activities.

II. Earthquake Incident in Makilala, Cotabato Province - Region XII

A. Situation Overview (Chronological Events)

27 February 2020

At 9:05 AM, a magnitude 4.3 earthquake with depth of focus of 11km was experienced in different parts of South- Central Mindanao and XI.

Intensity I - Alabel, Sarangani; Davao City

B. Effects

Suspension of classes

 As per Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council (LDRRMOs) report, at least four (4) Local Government Units (LGUs) declared suspension of classes in all levels both for public and private schools.

Casualty

• A total of one (1) person was reported dead and one (1) person was injured due to fallen debris.

C. Actions Taken

- MDRRMOs in Cotabato Province coordinated with BDRRMCs to report and update damages due to the earthquake incident.
- CDRRMC Kidapawan City is currently conducting ocular inspection and damage assessment.
- Kidapawan City 911 responded to 13 students from Kidapawan City National High School who suffered hyperventilation.
- OCD Regional Office XII is closely monitoring the incident.
