### **I. Preparedness Measures regarding 34<sup>th</sup> People Power Anniversary Commemoration (NCR)**

#### **A. Situation Overview**

In commemoration of the peaceful demonstration that occurred in 1986 at the Epifanio De Los Santos Avenue (EDSA), every 25th of February is declared a Special Non-working Holiday. A number of people are expected to celebrate and flock along EDSA (Ortigas-Santolan), EDSA Shrine, People Power Monument (Corner White Plains Avenue) and other public places in Metro Manila. The Metro Manila Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Council is closely monitoring for any eventualities thru coordination and collaboration with council members and City DRRMOs.

#### **B. Actions Taken**

##### **OCD NCR**

- Issued Memorandum MMDRRMC Memo No. 9, s. 2020 regarding on Alert Status in Observance of People Power Revolution Commemoration advising the Member Agencies and Local DRRMOs to be on heightened alert.
- Heightened alert status and continuously monitor the situation through the LDRRMOs for any eventualities on a 24/7 shifting schedule at OCD NCR Operations Center.

##### **NCRPO**

- Conducted Interagency Security Preparations Meeting on 9:00 AM, 24 February 2020 at QCPD Conference Room, Camp Karingal, Quezon City.
- Continuous monitoring for threats identified by intelligence community.

### **NICA NCR**

- Presented the threat assessment in connection with the activity to include the following agendas: Human Rights Violations, Press Freedom and Ouster groups.
- Continuous monitoring the activities of identified groups: protesters, ousters and other possible threats during the activity.

### **DILG NCR**

- Issued Memorandum to DILG Field Offices to accomplish the monitoring template with regard to peace and order situation:
  - Details of rallies, protests or other related activities, including the venues and involved personalities;
  - Affected routes, which may cause traffic congestions;
  - Actions undertaken by the city/municipal governments to maintain and ensure the peace and order and public safety within their areas of responsibility;
- Maintains close coordination with all seventeen (17) LGUs and shall be providing additional updates as necessary.

### **DSWD NCR**

- Continuous monitoring of weather conditions and other emergencies through telephone, internet, cell phone by the Disaster Response Management Division Staff and Quick Response Team Leaders.
- DROMIC Focal Person will prepare and consolidate disaster reports generated from the 24 hours monitoring.
- Continuous provision of Disaster Assistance Family Access Card to requesting LGUs.
- Ensured to maximize the availability and accessibility of four vehicles for possible deployment.
- Activated Quick Response Teams of DSWD-NCR and on standby in response to any eventualities.
- Continuous coordination with the Local Government Units thru their respective Local Social Welfare and Development Offices (LSWDOs) for reports on incidents requiring augmentation assistance from the FO-NCR.

### **CDRRMC Las Piñas City**

- Heightened alert status in anticipation of the influx of people in public places of the city on 8:00 AM, 24 February 2020 to 5:00PM, 25 February 2020.
- Placed all Emergency Response Personnel on standby for any disaster related eventualities that may arise from this occasion.
- Heightened alert status of all PNP Las Piñas City personnel to be on standby at their designated police precincts for possible civil disturbance management.
- Informed all barangays to closely monitor and manage the situation in their area of responsibility and coordinate with the CDRRM Operations Center.
- Continuously monitoring the situation on the ground at the CDRRM Operations Center through coordination with all concerned stakeholders.

### **CDRRMC Malabon City**

- Coordination, Command & Control (C3) with 21 Barangays, Volunteers and other stakeholders on standby for any eventualities.

- Placed response personnel, vehicles and equipment on standby for any eventualities.
- Continuously monitoring all media platforms regarding the event and maintains coordination with OCD, MMDA and DILG for the reports related to the event.

### **CDRRMC Manila City**

- Heightened alert and continuously monitoring for any eventualities.
- Placed Manila City Emergency Operations Center (EOC) Staff and Response Personnel are on standby for possible deployment.
- Prepositioned two (2) fire trucks and three (3) ambulances on standby alert at Manila Central Command and Control Center and one (1) fire truck, two (2) rescue truck, and one (1) mobile unit at Delpa Evacuation Center.

## **II. Initial Report Re Food Poisoning in Tupi, South Cotabato (Region XII)**

### **C. Situation Overview**

On 22 February 2020, a food poisoning transpired in Barangay Acmonan and Kablon, Tupi, South Cotabato. The incident happened after the victims had eaten bread and beef loaf from a nearby sari-sari store. Victims rushed to the Roel Senador Memorial Hospital, Tupi, South Cotabato for Medical Management, while Municipal Health Office of Tupi and the Provincial Health Office continue to investigate the incident.

### **D. Effects**

A total of **thirteen (13) persons** were admitted at Roel Senador Memorial Hospital, Tupi, South Cotabato.
