Initial Report regarding Fire Incident in Brgy. Takut-Takut, Jolo, Sulu (BARMM)

I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

- At around 09:15 AM, 03 February 2020, a fire incident transpired at Brgy Takut-Takut, Jolo, Sulu and immediately spread to the adjacent barangays.
- The fire was declared under control at 11:05 AM of the same day while it was declared fire out at 12:30 PM of the same day. The BFP is still on the process of investigation to determine the cause of the incident.

II. EFFECTS

A. AFFECTED POPULATION

A total of **1,572 families** were affected by the incident and are currently staying at Hadji Hassiman Elementary School and Sta. Nina Rasul Complex.

C. COST OF DAMAGE

An estimated cost of damage to property was incurred Php 17,000,000.00.

III. ACTIONS TAKEN

OCD BARMM

- Coordinated with MDRRMC Jolo and PDRRMC Sulu re Fire Incident.
- Continuous monitoring and coordination with MOH-BARMM re the number of casualties during the fire incident.

PDRRMC Sulu

- Assisted the MDRRMC Jolo in the conduct of assessment and validation of the affected families
- Continuous monitoring and validation on the numbers of affected population.
- Integrated Provincial Health Office (IPHO) Sulu provided medical assistance to the reported injured persons.

MDRRMC Jolo

- Conducted initial validation and assessment of affected families.
- MSWD Jolo along with the assistance of MDRRMC Jolo and PSWD Sulu identified Santanina Rasul Sport Complex, Tennis Court Municipal Compound, and Hasiman Elementary School as evacuation centers for the displaced families.
- Provided hot meals for the displaced families in the evacuation center.

BFP

- Responded and conducted fire suppression on the affected barangays.
- Investigated the cause of fire.

PRC

PRC Sulu provided medical assistance to the reported injured persons and served hot meals for 500 individuals.

TAUSUG League for Transformation

Provided hot meals and hygiene kits at Santa Nina Rasul Sport Complex.
