Progress Report regarding Fire Incident in Brgy. Takut-Takut, Jolo, Sulu (BARMM)

I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

03 February 2020

- At around 09:15 AM, a fire incident transpired at Brgy Takut-Takut, Jolo, Sulu and immediately spread to the adjacent barangays and razed multiple house made of light materials.
- At around 11:05 AM the fire incident was declared under control leaving three (3) barangays affected namely Barangay Takot Takot, Tulay, and Chinese Pier, Jolo, Sulu.
- At around 12:46 PM, the BFP declared fire out, however, the cause of the incident and estimated damage is still on the process of investigation.

II. EFFECTS

A. AFFECTED POPULATION

A total of 2,827 families / 16,703 persons were affected by the incident.

C. COST OF DAMAGE

A total of ₱17,000,000.00 estimated cost of damage to property due to the incident.

III. ACTIONS TAKEN

OCD BARMM

- · Coordinated with MDRRMC Jolo and PDRRMC Sulu re Fire Incident.
- Continuous monitoring and coordination with MOH-BARMM re the number of casualties during the fire incident.
- BARRM Rapid Emergency Action on Disaster Incident (READI) provided 3,000 packs of food items to the affected families.

PDRRMC Sulu

- Assisted the MDRRMC Jolo in the conduct of assessment and validation of the affected families
- Continuous monitoring and validation on the numbers of affected population.
- Integrated Provincial Health Office (IPHO) Sulu provided medical assistance to the reported injured persons.

MDRRMC Jolo

- · Conducted initial validation and assessment of affected families.
- MSWD Jolo along with the assistance of MDRRMC Jolo and PSWD Sulu identified Santanina Rasul Sport Complex, Tennis Court Municipal Compound, and Hasiman Elementary School as evacuation centers for the displaced families.
- Provided hot meals for the displaced families in the evacuation center.
- Continuously providing feeding program for all the affected families.
- Rural Health Unit Jolo conducted free medical check-up in the evacuation centers.
- BFP, MDRRMO, and MJIATG conducted aerial survey in the incident affected areas.
- Conducted Relief Operation together with GMA Kapuso Foundation providing 1,200 Food Items to Sta Nina Sport Complex EC, Tennis

Court EC and home Base at Brgy. Chinese Pier Evacuation Center on 7 February 2020.

BFP

- Responded and conducted fire suppression on the affected barangays.
- · Investigated the cause of fire.

PRC

PRC Sulu provided medical assistance to the reported injured persons and served hot meals for 500 individuals.

TAUSUG League for Transformation

Provided hot meals and hygiene kits at Santa Nina Rasul Sport Complex.
