I. Background:

A strong earthquake with a preliminary magnitude of 6.6 occurred in Vanuatu on 07 September 2020 at 2:13 PM (Philippine Standard Time) located at 17.1°S, 168.5 °E with depth of 10 km. No destructive tsunami threat exists based on available data.

This is for information purposes only and there is **NO TSUNAMI THREAT** to the Philippines from this earthquake.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN:

- NDRRMC Advisory on the tsunami information was disseminated to **OCD I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, CARAGA, CAR, NCR, and BARMM** through facsimile, SMS and website for further dissemination to their respective Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
