MODERATE TO STRONG WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

SEABOARDS	WEATHER	WIND FORCE (KPH /KNOTS)	SEA CONDITION	WAVE HEIGHT (meters)
THE NORTHERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON (Batanes, Babuyan, Calayan, the northern coast of Ilocos Norte, and the northern coast of Cagayan)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains	41-52 / 22-28	Moderate to rough	2.5 – 3.4
