<b>THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF SOUTHERN LUZON</b> [northern and eastern coasts of Catanduanes, eastern coast of Albay (Rapu-Rapu Island and Batan Island), and the eastern coast of Sorsogon]	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers	45 - 63 / 24 - 34	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 4.5
<b>THE EASTERN SEABOARDS OF VISAYAS AND MINDANAO</b> (northern and eastern coasts of Samar Provinces, Dinagat Island, Siargao, Surigao del Sur, Davao Oriental and Davao Occidental)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms	45 - 63 / 24 - 34	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 4.5
