AREAS:**

<b>THE SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON AND THE EASTERN SEABOARDS OF CENTRAL, SOUTHERN LUZON, AND VISAYAS</b> (Batanes, Cagayan including Babuyan Islands, Isabela, Aurora, Quezon, Polillio group of Islands, [Polillio, Patnanungan and Jomalig], northern coasts of Camarines Provinces, northern and eastern coasts of Catanduanes, eastern coast of Sorsogon, northern and eastern coasts of Samar Province)	Cloudy skies with light rains	45 - 63 / 24 - 34	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 4.5
<b>THE WESTERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON</b> (Ilocos Norte, Ilocos Sur, La Union, and Pangasinan)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains	45 - 63 / 24 - 34	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 4.5
