AREAS:**

THE WESTERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN AND CENTRAL LUZON (Ilocos Norte, Ilocos Sur, La Union, Pangasinan, and Zambales)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated light rains	45 - 63 / 24 - 34	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 4.5
THE EASTERN SEABOARD OF MINDANAO (Siargao Island)	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms	45 - 63 / 24 - 34	Rough to very rough	2.8 to 4.5
