Initial Report regarding Fire Incident in Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City (NCR)

A. Situation Overview

On 6 June 2020, 3:03 AM, a fire incident occurred in Addition Hills, Mandaluyong City. The fire reached 5th alarm at 3:51 AM and fireout was declared at 5:40 AM on the same day.

B. Effects

- A total of 600 families were affected with 1 casualty reported.
- 200 residential houses made of light materials were burned.

C. Actions Taken

- OCD-NCR is continuously monitoring the incident.
- BFP-NCR immediately responded to the incident.
- DSWD-NCR is continuously coordinating with Mandaluyong CSWDO for updates and for any augmentation and assistance needed.
- Mandaluyong City Social Welfare and Development Office (CSWDO)
 - Coordinated with concerned agencies and conducted assessment and validation of the affected families using the Disaster Assistance Family Access Card (DAFAC) / White Card
 - Facilitated the provision of water and hot meals.
 - Identified evacuation areas together with the barangay.
- Mandaluyong Local Government Unit together with the Barangay Officials immediately assisted the affected families and secured the place to maintain peace and order in the area.

- Mandaluyong Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Office assisted in response operations.
