PRESENT WEATHER:

At **3:00 PM** today, the Low-Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **325 km Southeast** of Hinatuan, Surigao Del Sur or **370 KM East of General Santos City, South Cotabato (6.4 °N, 128.5 °E)**. Northeast Monsoon affecting Northern Luzon.

People living near the mountain slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above-mentioned river systems and the **Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils** concerned are advised to take necessary precautionary measures.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
