**PRESENT WEATHER:**

At **3:00 PM** today, the Low-Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at **355 km** West Northwest of Zamboanga City, Zamboanga del Sur or **155 Km East Southeast of Puerto Princesa City Palawan (9.4 °N, 120.1 °E)**. Northeast Monsoon affecting **extreme** Northern Luzon.
