I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 145 km West of General Santos City over Moro Gulf (5.9° N, 123.9° E). The combined effect of the LPA and the tail-end of a cold front will bring scattered moderate to occasionally heavy rains over Visayas, Bicol Region, Zamboanga Peninsula, BARMM, Northern Mindanao, CARAGA, and the provinces of Marinduque and Romblon.

Residents in the aforementioned areas, especially those living in highly susceptible to flooding and rain-induced landslides are advised to take appropriate actions, coordinate with the local disaster risk reduction and management offices (LDRRMO), and continue monitoring for updates including the thunderstorms or rainfall advisories, heavy rainfall warnings issued by the PAGASA Regional Services Division.


You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions, as necessary.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
