### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

At 10:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 100 km Northwest of Zamboanga City, Zamboanga Del Sur (7.5° N, 121.4° E). The combined effect of the LPA and the tail-end of a cold front will bring scattered moderate to occasionally heavy rains over Palawan, Camarines Norte, Camarines Sur, Catanduanes, Albay, and Sorsogon.

Residents in the aforementioned areas, especially those living in highly susceptible to flooding and rain-induced landslides are advised to take appropriate actions, coordinate with the local disaster risk reduction and management offices (LDRRMO), and continue monitoring for updates including the thunderstorms or rainfall advisories, heavy rainfall warnings issued by the PAGASA Regional Services Division.

### **II. ACTIONS TAKEN:**

NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 02** to OCD Regional Offices **MIMAROPA and V**, through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
