I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

As of 25 March 2020, a total of **552 confirmed COVID-19 cases** were monitored/reported. Of which, 35 persons were declared dead while 20 persons have already recovered. Meanwhile, 615 persons are considered Persons Under Investigation (PUIs).

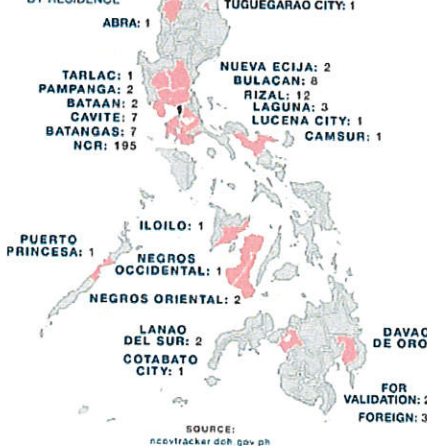

A. Suspension of Work

Suspension of Work

1. Per Memorandum from the Executive Secretary, starting 17 March 2020, a work from home arrangement will be implemented in the Executive Branch, except PNP,

AFP, PCG, and health and emergency frontline services, border control and other critical services, which shall ensure a skeletal work force.

2. Work in all government offices in the Provinces of Ilocos Norte and La Union were declared suspended on 14 March 2020 and 16 March 2020, respectively.

III. DISASTER RESPONSE ACTIONS

DIRECTIVES AND RESOLUTIONS:

- On 08 March 2020, with the recommendation of the DOH, the Office of the President declared a State of Public Health Emergency through Proclamation No. 922, s. 2020. This will facilitate mobilization of resources, ease processes including procurement of critical logistics and supplies, and intensify reporting.
- On 12 March 2020, 9:00 PM, a Presidential Press conference was conducted announcing the raising of the Philippine's COVID-19 Alert Level System to Code Red Sublevel 2. The Chief Executive approved the imposition of Stringent Social Distancing Measures in the National Capital Region (NCR) for thirty (30) days, effective 15 March 2020.
- On 16 March 2020, a Memorandum from the Executive Secretary was issued placing the entire Luzon under Enhanced Community Quarantine.
- The entire Philippines was declared under State of Calamity due to Corona Virus Disease 2019 as per Presidential Proclamation No. 929 dated 16 March 2020.
