I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

- On 31 December 2019, a clustering of pneumonia cases of unknown etiology was reported in Wuhan, China. The outbreak was later determined to be caused by a new coronavirus strain that has not been previously identified in humans.
- On 30 January 2020, the Department of Health (DOH) confirmed the first case in the Philippines when a 38-year-old female Chinese patient under investigation (PUI) tested positive for the COVID-19.
- In light of the confirmation of localized transmission in the country and in anticipation of possible sustained community transmission, DOH has raised the COVID-19 Alert System to Code Red Sublevel 1 on 07 March 2020.
- On 08 March 2020, with the recommendation of the DOH, the Office of the President declared a State of Public Health Emergency through Proclamation No. 922, s. 2020. This will facilitate mobilization of resources, ease processes including procurement of critical logistics and supplies, and intensify reporting.
- On 12 March 2020, 9:00 PM, a Presidential Press Conference was conducted announcing the raising of the Philippine's COVID-19 Alert Level System to Code Red Sublevel 2. The Chief Executive approved the imposition of Stringent Social Distancing Measures in the National Capital Region (NCR) for thirty (30) days, effective 15 March 2020.
- **On 16 March 2020, a Memorandum from the Executive Secretary was issued re Community Quarantine Over the Entire Luzon and Further Guidelines for the Management of the Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) Situation.**

II. EFFECTS

A. Patients Under Investigation (PUI) and Confirmed Cases

- As of **17 March 2020**, there are **214 Patients Under Investigation (PUI)** (previous report: 153 PUIs) who are currently admitted in different facilities in Regions I, II, III, CALABARZON, VI, VII, VIII, X, XI, XII, CARAGA, BARMM, CAR, and NCR.
- A total of **142 Confirmed Cases** (previous report: 64 cases) were confirmed in Regions III, CALABARZON, VII, X, and NCR. Of which, **12 were reported dead** (previous report: 6), **three (3) have recovered**.

B. Suspension of Classes and Work

Suspension of Classes (Tab A)

A total of **656 cities/municipalities** in Regions **I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, VI, VII, IX, XII, and NCR** declared suspension of classes.

Suspension of Work

- 1. Per Memorandum from the Executive Secretary, starting 17 March 2020, a work from home arrangement will be implemented in the Executive branch, except PNP, AFP, PCG, and health and emergency frontline services, border control and other critical services, which shall ensure a skeletal work force.**
- 2. Work in all government offices in the Provinces of Ilocos Norte and La Union were declared suspended on 14 March 2020 and 16 March 2020, respectively.**

C. Suspension of Domestic Travel

Land, domestic air, and domestic sea travel to and from Metro Manila is suspended from 15 March to 14 April 2020 as declared by President Rodrigo Roa Duterte during the Presidential Press Conference conducted on 12 March 2020.

D. Declaration of State of Calamity

The Province of Isabela was declared under State of Calamity through Resolution No. 2020-09-4, s. 2020 dated 10 March 2020.
