STRONG TO GALE WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

SEABOARDS	WEATHER	WIND FORCE (KPH /KNOTS)	SEA CONDITION	WAVE HEIGHT (meters)
THE NORTHERN AND EASTERN SEABOARD OF LUZON (Batanes, Cagayan Including Babuyan Group of Islands, Northern Coast of Cagayan Including Babuyan Group of Islands and Northern coast of Ilocos Norte)	Cloudy skies with light rains	30 - 44 / 16 - 24	Rough to very rough	1.2 - 2.8
