<b>THE WESTERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON</b> (Ilocos Sur and <b>Western Coast of Ilocos Norte</b> )	Partly cloudy to cloudy skies with isolated rains	45 - 63 / 24 - 34	Rough to very rough	2.8 - 4.5
