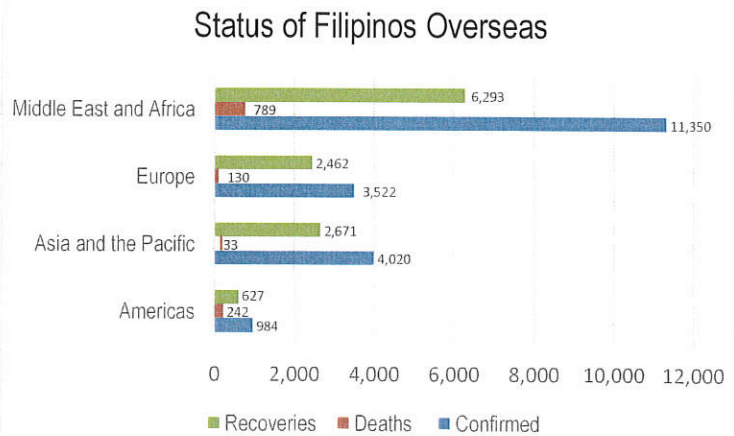

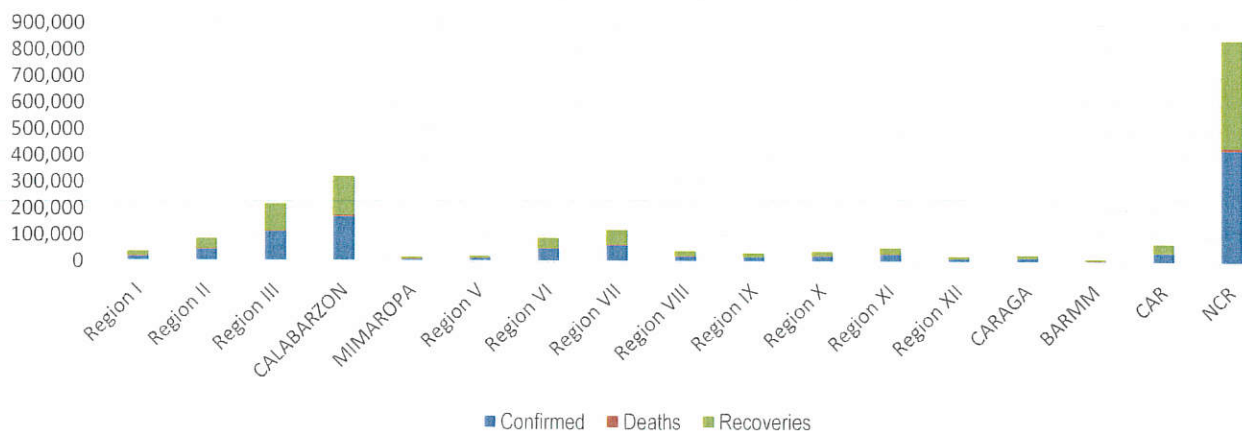

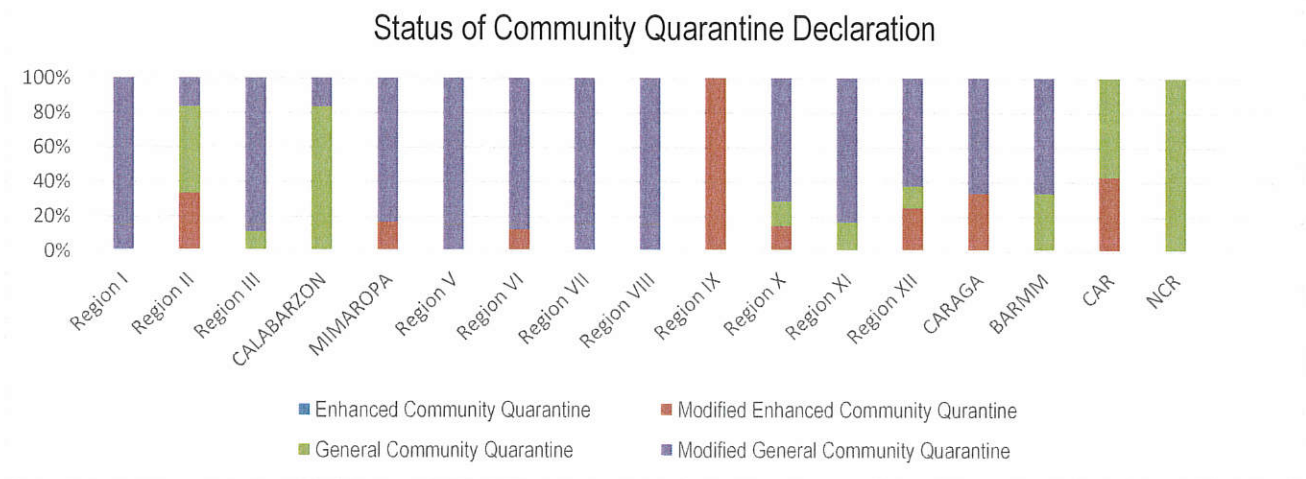


# P-D-I-T-R STRATEGY

With reference to the National Action Plan (NAP) for COVID-19, the National Task Force is intensifying efforts to PREVENT the spread of the COVID-19, TEST individuals, and communities, ISOLATE those that are identified to be confirmed cases, TREAT and provide with appropriate health care, and REINTEGRATE them back to the community.

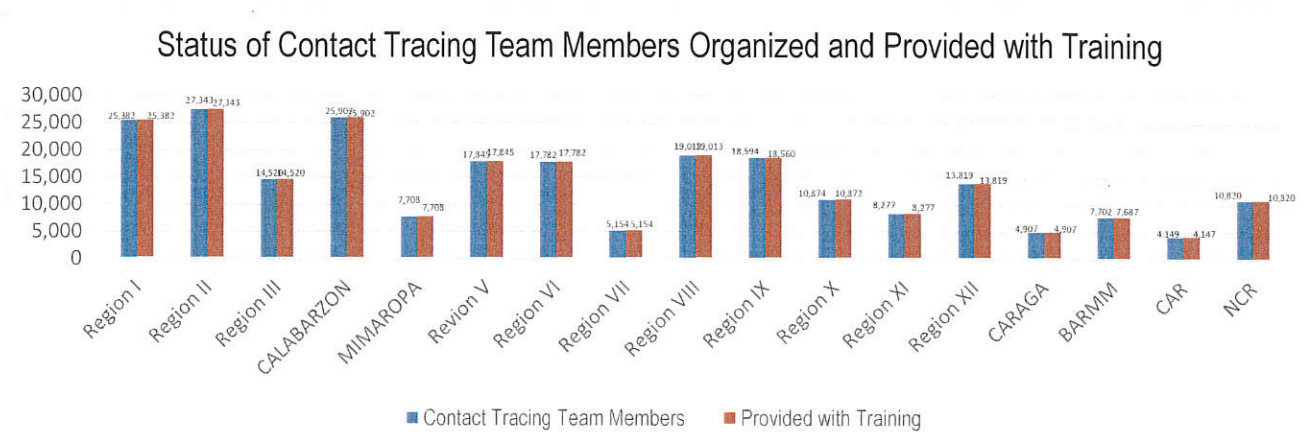
## PREVENT

PREVENT enables to change mindsets and behaviors to advocate for shared responsibility in ensuring compliance to minimum public health standards and protocols and address stigma and division in the communities, workplaces, schools. To implement the PREVENT strategy, community quarantine declarations are made in various localities, enforcing stricter regulations and disease preventive measures particular for areas with high cases. The status of community quarantine declarations is summarized as follows:



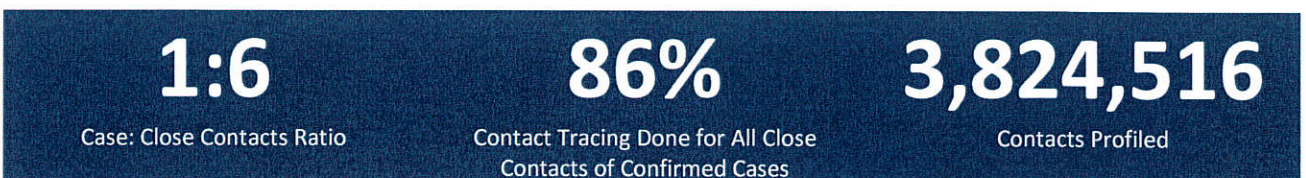
## DETECT

DETECT entails active screening of those presenting with signs and symptoms of COVID-19 in the community as well as other disease surveillance activities. For this purpose, contact tracing teams have been organized and provided with appropriate training. Summary is as follows:

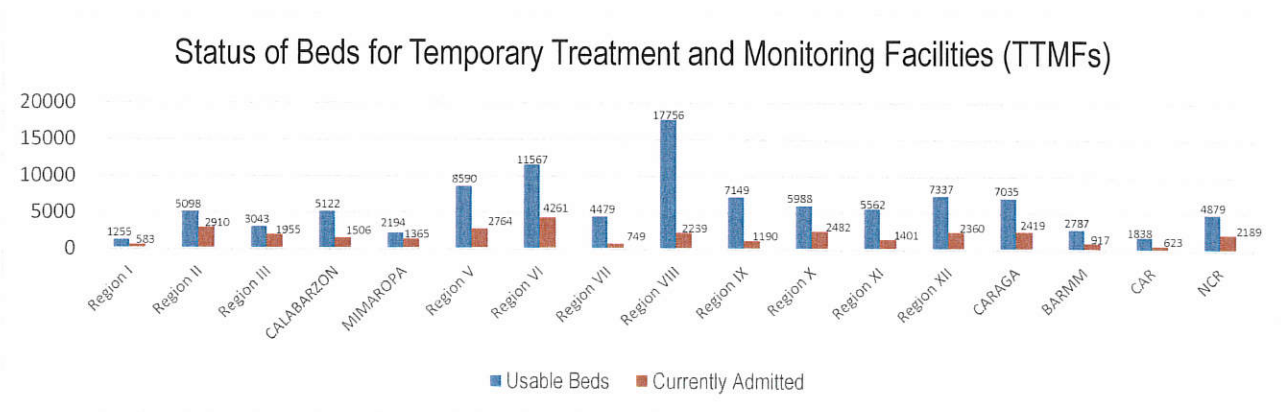

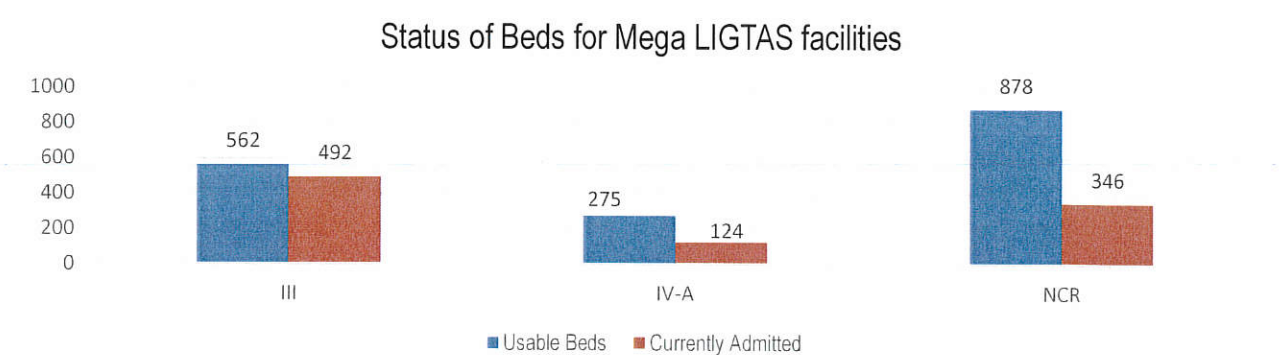

## ISOLATE

Isolate involves implementation of measures to separate those identified as exposed and confirmed cases and provide medical interventions to further prevent the spread of the disease. This strategy involves setting up of Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facilities (TTMFs). The summary of TTMFs established is as follows:

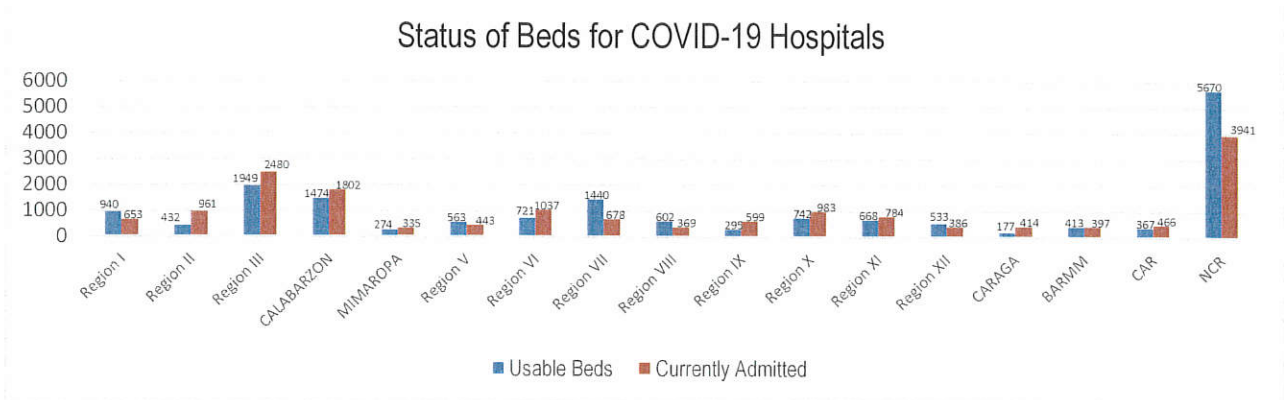

For the TREAT strategy, One Hospital Command has been established to facilitate a centralized referral system. Further, wards, isolation, and intensive care units are in operation to provide treatment services for COVID-19 positives. **NARRATIVE REPORT  
04 June 2021**

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ACTIONS TAKEN: Management of Returning Overseas Filipinos (MROF)

The Task Group on Management of Returning Overseas Filipinos (TG-MROF) was created by the National Incident Command-National Task Force COVID 19 to solely cater to the medical and social needs of Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs). The TG-MROF in coordination with various government agencies, private entities, and other task groups created to respond with the prevailing crisis, regional task units, and local government agencies that are task to facilitate the safe return of the ROFs back to their home provinces.

**Members:** DND, DOTr, DOLE, DILG, DFA, DOT, DSWD, DOH, OCD, OWWA, BOQ, CAAP, MARINA, PCG, PNP and AFP

**ARRIVALS:** As of 02 June 2021, a total of **1,153,194 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs)** arrived at the NAIA Terminals 1, 2, and 3, Clark International Airport, Mactan-Cebu International Airport, South Harbor, Subic, Bataan, and Zamboanga Port. Of which, **543,715** are **land-based** OFWs, **390,522** are **sea-based** OFWs and **215,277** are **non-OFWs**.

A total of **3,680 deceased ROFs** had arrived in the country from 01 July 2020 – 03 June 2021. Of which, **502** died due to COVID-19.

**TESTING:** From May 9, 2020 to 31 January 2021, a total of **810,134** ROFs were tested thru RT-PCR.

**6<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF SWABBING:** From 01 February to 13 May 2021, a total of **233,767** Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) were tested thru RT-PCR, on the 6<sup>th</sup> day of their quarantine period.

**7<sup>TH</sup> DAY OF SWABBING:** As of 02 June 2021, a total of **42,481 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs)** were tested thru RT-PCR on the 7<sup>th</sup> day of their quarantine period. Of which, **29,847** were tested by PCG, **5,066** were tested by BOQ Clark, **4,159** were tested by Detoxicare and **3,409** were tested by PADL.

**SWABBING UPON ARRIVAL:** As of 02 June 2021, a total of **1,769 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs)** were tested thru RT-PCR upon arrival at Mactan Cebu International Airport by DOH-RESU 7.

**QUARANTINE:** As of 03 June 2021, a total of **17,832** ROFs were confirmed positive with COVID-19. Of which, **202** are admitted at **15** quarantine facilities, **17,613** were able to recover and **17** died.

**DEPARTURES:** As of 02 June 2021, TG-MROF was able to assist **638,205** ROFs back to their home provinces. Of which, **244,366** were assisted by land, **297,747** by air, and **96,092** by sea.

**ASSISTANCE:** As of 25 April 2021, a total of **833,221** OFWs were assisted thru OWWA. Of which, **269,495** were assisted through the “Hatid-Sundo” Program, **537,136** through the “OFW Kalinga” Program, **7,123** were assisted through the “Tulong Marino” Program and **19,467** assistances to stranded OFWs in the region.

**RETURNING FILIPINOS (REFs) from SABAH:** As of 17 April 2021, a total of **2,953** REFs from Sabah arrived in the country and were assisted to go back in their home provinces.

**TRAVEL BANNED COUNTRIES:** As of 01 June 2021, Travelers from **7** countries are prohibited to enter the Philippines until 15 June, 2021. A total of **42** countries were issued a travel restriction by the Philippines since 26 December 2020.

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
