



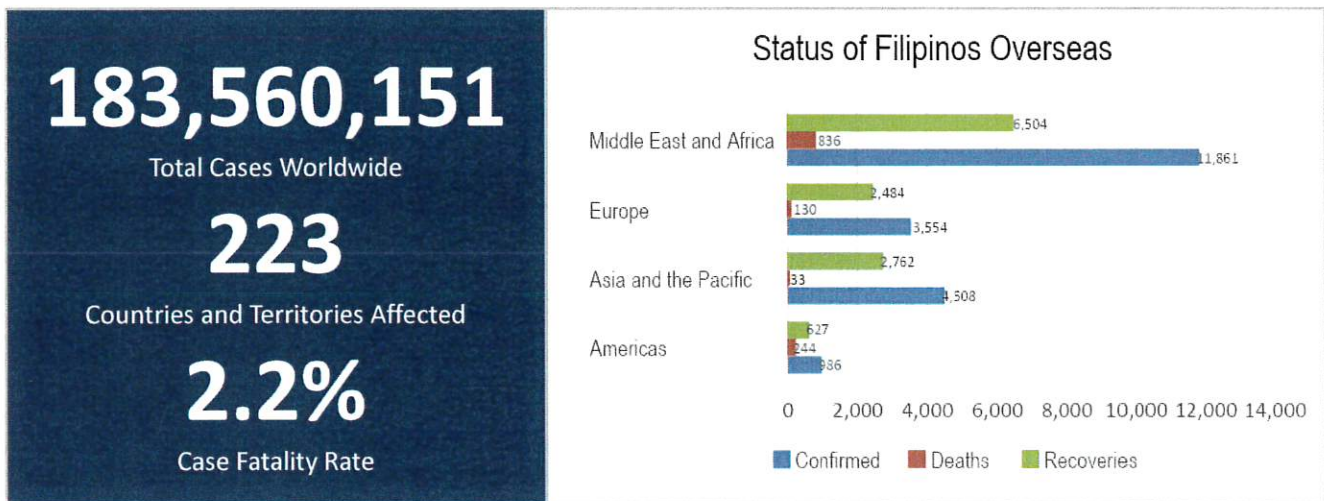

GLOBAL SITUATION

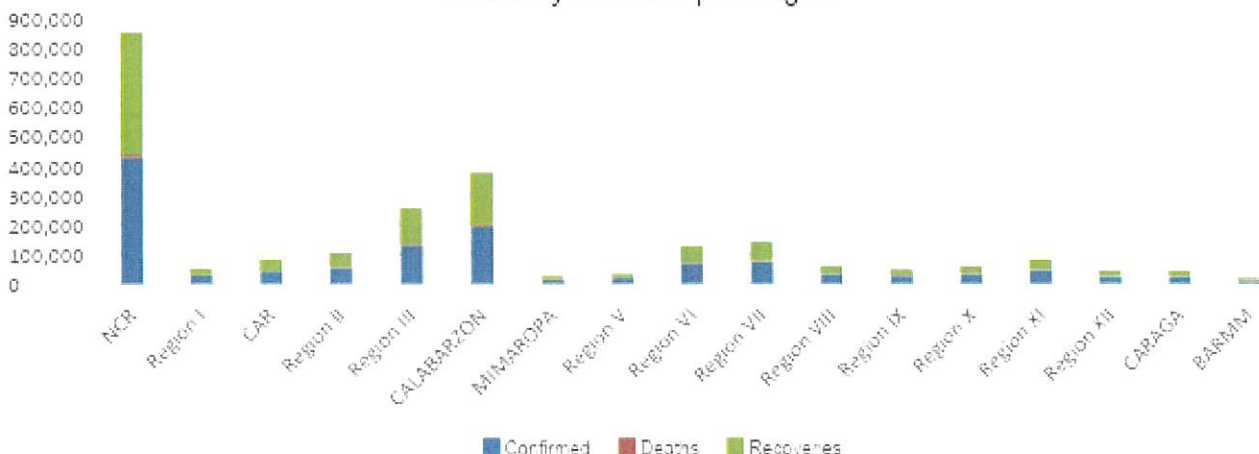

Summary of Cases per Region



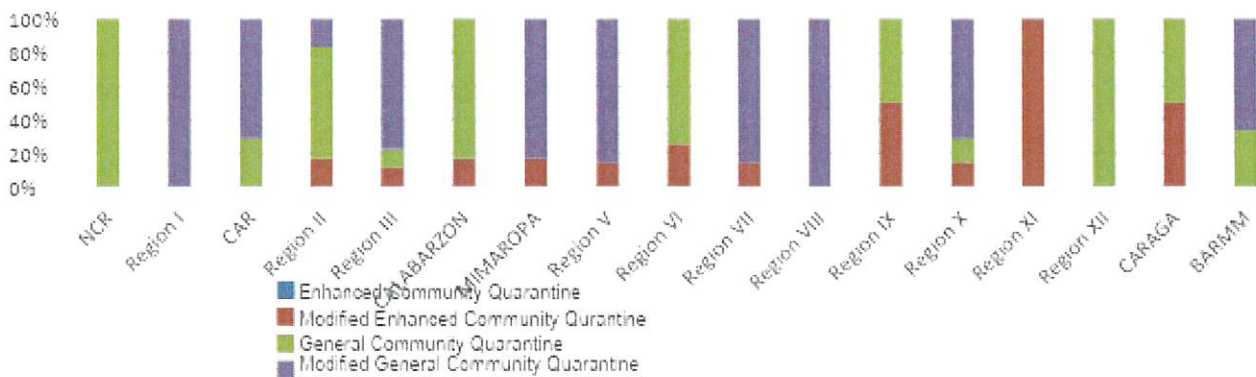
P-D-I-T-R STRATEGY

With reference to the National Action Plan (NAP) for COVID-19, the National Task Force is intensifying efforts to PREVENT the spread of the COVID-19, TEST individuals, and communities, ISOLATE those that are identified to be confirmed cases, TREAT and provide with appropriate health care, and REINTEGRATE them back to the community.

PREVENT

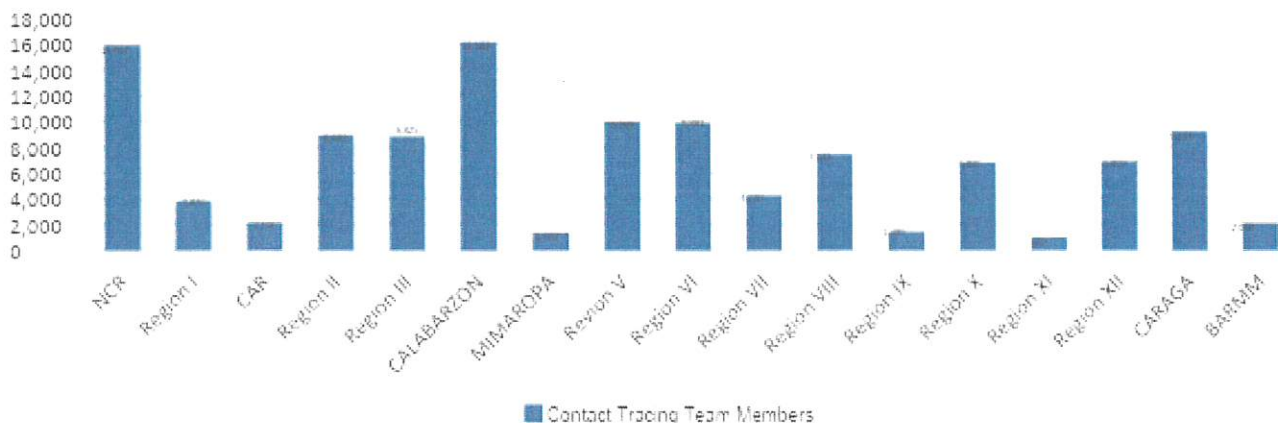
PREVENT enables to change mindsets and behaviors to advocate for shared responsibility in ensuring compliance to minimum public health standards and protocols and address stigma and division in the communities, workplaces, schools. To implement the PREVENT strategy, community quarantine declarations are made in various localities, enforcing stricter regulations and disease preventive measures particular for areas with high cases. The status of community quarantine declarations is summarized as follows:

DETECT

DETECT entails active screening of those presenting with signs and symptoms of COVID-19 in the community as well as other disease surveillance activities. For this purpose, contact tracing teams have been organized and provided with appropriate training. Summary is as follows:

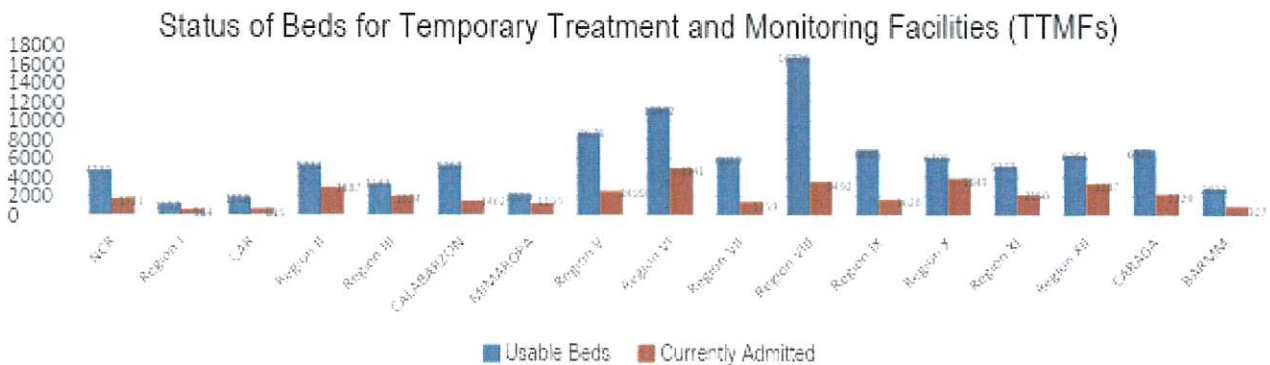

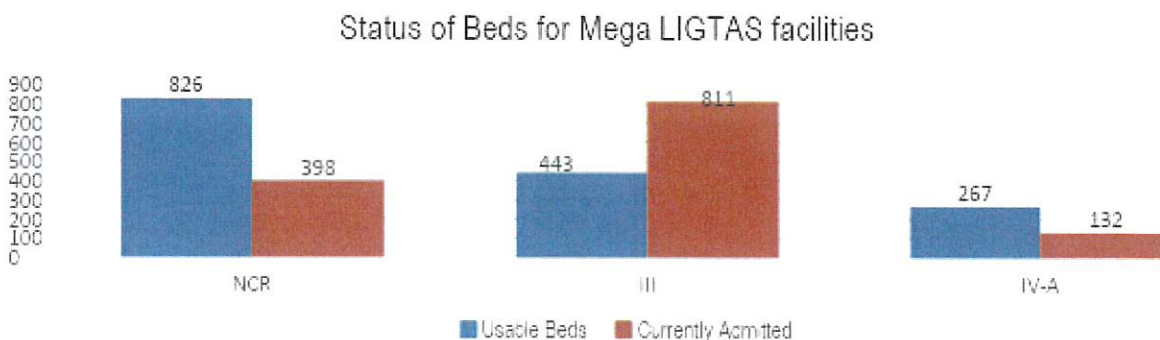
ISOLATE

Isolate involves implementation of measures to separate those identified as exposed and confirmed cases and provide medical interventions to further prevent the spread of the disease. 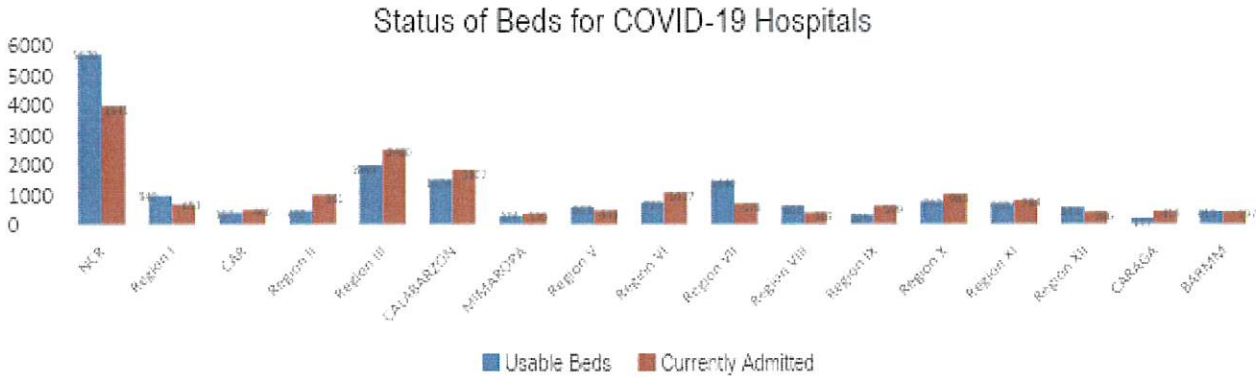

For the TREAT strategy, One Hospital Command has been established to facilitate a centralized referral system. Further, wards, isolation, and intensive care units are in operation to provide treatment services for COVID-19 positives. 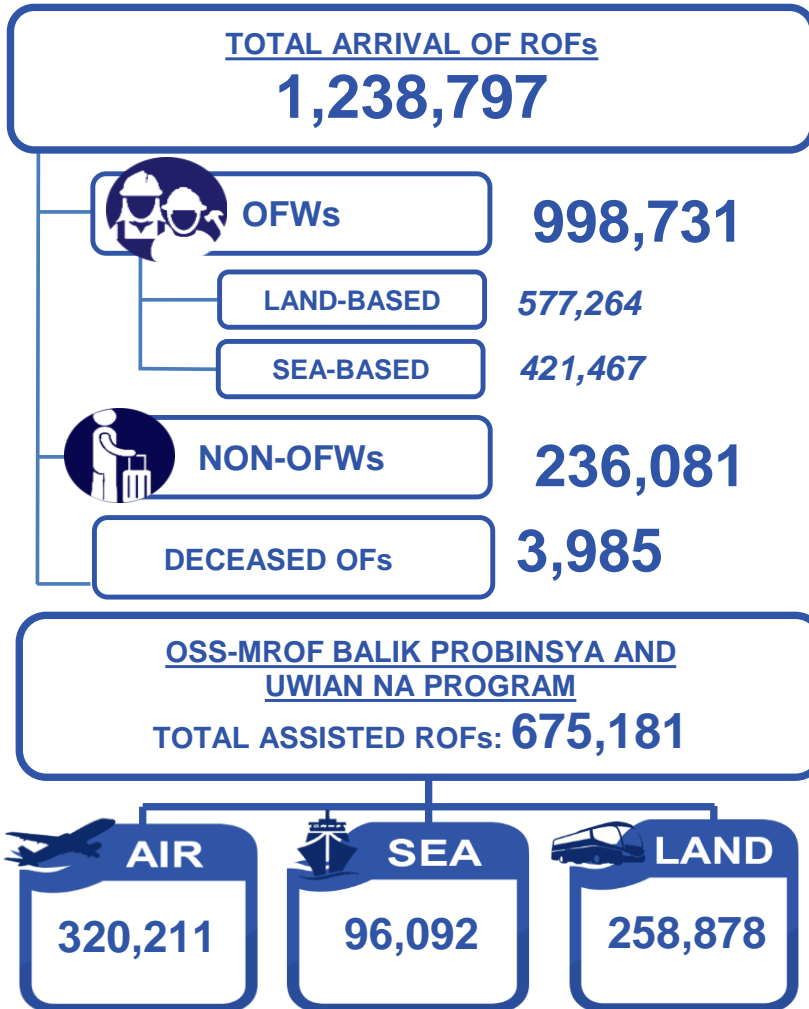

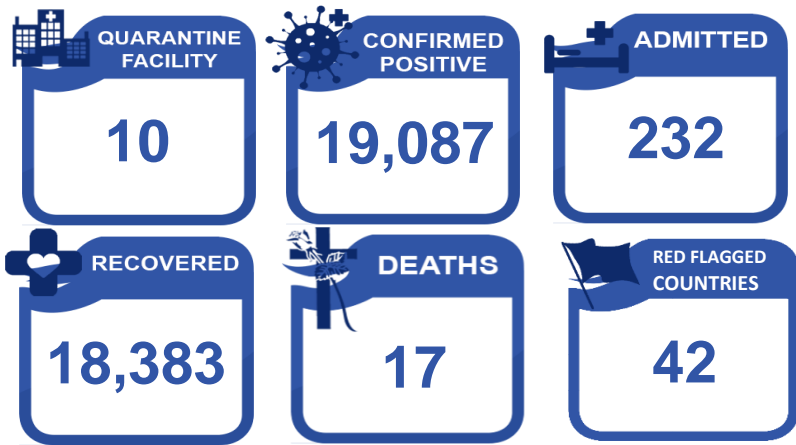

NARRATIVE REPORT

05 July 2021

ACTIONS TAKEN: Management of Returning Overseas Filipinos (MROF)

The Task Group on Management of Returning Overseas Filipinos (TG-MROF) was created by the National Incident Command-National Task Force COVID 19 to solely cater to the medical and social needs of Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs). The TG-MROF in coordination with various government agencies, private entities, and other task groups created to respond with the prevailing crisis, regional task units, and local government agencies that are task to facilitate the safe return of the ROFs back to their home provinces.

Members: DND, DOTr, DOLE, DILG, DFA, DOT, DSWD, DOH, OCD, OWWA, BOQ, CAAP, MARINA, PCG, PNP and AFP

ARRIVALS: As of 03 July 2021, a total of 1,238,797 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) arrived at the NAIA Terminals 1, 2, and 3, Clark International Airport, Mactan-Cebu International Airport, Laoag International Airport, South Harbor, Subic, Bataan, and Zamboanga Port. Of which, a total of 998,731 are OFWs (577,264 are land-based and 421,467 are sea-based) and 236,081 are non-OFWs.

A total of 3,985 deceased ROFs had arrived in the country from 03 July 2020 – 04 July 2021. Of which, 537 died due to COVID-19.

TESTING: From May 9, 2020 to 31 January 2021, a total of 810,134 ROFs were tested thru RT-PCR.

6TH DAY OF SWABBING OPERATIONS: From 01 February to 13 May 2021, a total of 233,767 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) were tested thru RT-PCR, on the 6th day of their quarantine period.

7TH DAY OF SWABBING OPERATIONS: As of 03 July 2021, a total of 124,504 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) were tested thru RT-PCR on the 7th day of their quarantine period. Of which, 82,337 were tested by PCG, 12,123 were tested by BOQ Clark, 13,317 were tested by Detoxicare, 12,262 were tested by PADL, and 4,465 were tested by DOH-RESU 7.

QUARANTINE: As of 04 July 2021, a total of 19,087 ROFs were confirmed positive with COVID-19. Of which, 232 are admitted at 10 quarantine facilities, 18,383 were able to recover and 17 died.

OSS-MROF BALIK PROBINSYA AND UWIAN NA PROGRAM: As of 03 July 2021, a total of 675,181 ROFs were assisted back to their home provinces. Of which, 258,878 were assisted by land, 320,211 by air, and 96,092 by sea.

OWWA COVID-19 RELATED ASSISTANCE TO OFWs: From March 2020 to June 27, 2021, a total of 596,341 OFWs were assisted by OWWA on their "Returned to Home Regions" program and 612,236 OFWs are also assisted through "OFW Kalinga" program.

RETURNING FILIPINOS (REFs) from SABAH: As of 22 May 2021, a total of 3,985 REFs from Sabah had arrived in the country. While as of 21 June 2021, a total of 4,683 remaining Filipinos are still in Sabah for transfer.

TRAVEL BANNED COUNTRIES: As of 01 June 2021, Travelers from 7 countries are prohibited to enter the Philippines until 15 July, 2021. A total of 42 countries were issued a travel restriction by the Philippines since 26 December 2020.

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
