

GLOBAL SITUATION





P-D-I-T-R STRATEGY

With reference to the National Action Plan (NAP) for COVID-19, the National Task Force is intensifying efforts to PREVENT the spread of the COVID-19, TEST individuals, and communities, ISOLATE those that are identified to be confirmed cases, TREAT and provide with appropriate health care, and REINTEGRATE them back to the community.

DETECT

DETECT entails active screening of those presenting with signs and symptoms of COVID-19 in the community as well as other disease surveillance activities. For this purpose, contact tracing teams have been organized and provided with appropriate training. Summary is as follows:





ISOLATE

Isolate involves implementation of measures to separate those identified as exposed and confirmed cases and provide medical interventions to further prevent the spread of the disease. 

NARRATIVE REPORT 29 September 2021

ACTIONS TAKEN: Management of Returning Overseas Filipinos (MROF)

The Task Group on Management of Returning Overseas Filipinos (TG-MROF) was created by the National Incident Command-National Task Force COVID 19 to solely cater to the medical and social needs of Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs). The TG-MROF in coordination with various government agencies, private entities, and other task groups created to response with the prevailing crisis, regional task units, and local government agencies that are task to facilitate the safe return of the ROFs back to their home provinces.

Members: DND, DOTr, DOLE, DILG, DFA, DOT, DSWD, DOH, OCD, OWWA, BOQ, CAAP, MARINA, PCG, PNP and AFP

ARRIVALS: As of 28 September 2021, a total of 1,509,686 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) arrived at the NAIA Terminals 1, 2, and 3, Clark International Airport, Mactan-Cebu International Airport, Laoag International Airport, South Harbor, Subic, Bataan, Zamboanga, and Batangas Port. Of which, a total of 1,196,234 are OFWs (680,354 are land-based and 515,880 are sea-based) and 308,643 are non-OFWs

A total of 4,809 deceased ROFs had arrived in the country from 07 July 2020 - 29 September 2021. Of which, 628 died due to COVID-19.

TESTING: From May 9, 2020 to 31 January 2021, a total of <u>810,134</u> ROFs were tested thru RT-PCR.

6TH DAY OF SWABBING OPERATIONS: From 01 February to 13 May 2021, a total of 233,767 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) were tested thru RT-PCR, on the 6th day of their quarantine period.

7TH DAY OF SWABBING OPERATIONS: As of 28 September, a total of 371,680 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) were tested thru RT-PCR on the 7th day of their quarantine period. Of which, 215,926 were tested by PCG, 35,038 were tested by BOQ Clark, 36,528 were tested by Detoxicare, 35,435 were tested by PADL, 39,696 were tested by DOH-RESU 7, 266 were tested by M. Mariano Memorial Hospital, 3,121 were tested by Southern Philippine Medical Center, and 5,670 were tested by BOQ Subic.

QUARANTINE: As of 29 September 2021, a total of 23,073 ROFs were confirmed positive with COVID-19. Of which, 311 are admitted at 16 quarantine facilities, 22,740 were able to recover and 22 died.

OSS-MROF BALIK PROBINSYA AND UWIAN NA PROGRAM: As of 29 September 2021, a total of 781,069 ROFs were assisted back to their home provinces. Of which, 307,281 were assisted by land, 377,696 by air, and 96,092 by sea.

OWWA COVID-19 RELATED ASSISTANCE TO OFWs: From March 2020 to 26 September, 2021, a total of 709,290 OFWs were assisted by OWWA on their "Returned to Home Regions" program and 734,364 OFWs are also assisted through "OFW Kalinga" program.

RETURNING FILIPINOS (REFs) from SABAH: As of 22 May 2021, a total of 3,289 REFs from Sabah had arrived in the country. While as of 21 June 2021, a total of 4,683 remaining Filipinos are still in Sabah for transfer.

TRAVEL BANNED COUNTRIES: As of 10 September 2021, the President approved the imposition of travel restrictions on 9 countries under Red List. These includes Azerbaijan, Guadeloupe, Guam, Israel, Kosovo, Montenegro, North Macedonia, Saint Lucia, and Switzerland shall prohibited from entering the country effective 12 September 2021.
