





#### NARRATIVE REPORT 22 April 2022

ACTIONS TAKEN: Management of Returning Overseas Filipinos (MROF)

The Task Group on Management of Returning Overseas Filipinos (TG-MROF) was created by the National Incident Command-National Task Force COVID 19 to solely cater to the medical and social needs of Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs). The TG-MROF in coordination with various government agencies, private entities, and other task groups created to response with the prevailing crisis, regional task units, and local government agencies that are task to facilitate the safe return of the ROFs back to their home provinces.

**Members:** DND, DOTr, DOLE, DILG, DFA, DOT, DSWD, DOH, OCD, OWWA, BOQ, CAAP, MARINA, PCG, PNP and AFP

ARRIVALS: As of 21 April 2022, a total of <a href="mailto:2,813,526">2,813,526</a> Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) arrived at the NAIA Terminals 1, 2, and 3, Clark International Airport, Mactan-Cebu International Airport, Laoag International Airport, South Harbor, Subic, Bataan, Zamboanga, and Batangas Port. Of which, a total of <a href="mailto:1,942,537">1,942,537</a> are OFWs (1,199,062 are land-based and <a href="mailto:243,475">743,475</a> are sea-based) and <a href="mailto:653,905">653,905</a> are non-OFWs including <a href="mailto:210,718">210,718</a> Foreign Nationals.

A total of <u>6,366</u> deceased ROFs had arrived in the country from 07 July 2020 – 22 April 2022. Of which, 640 died due to COVID-19.

**QUARANTINE**: As of 22 April 2022, a total of <u>32,455</u> ROFs were confirmed positive with COVID-19. Of which, <u>44</u> are admitted at <u>11</u> quarantine facilities, <u>32,383</u> were able to recover and <u>29</u> died.

OSS-MROF BALIK PROBINSYA AND UWIAN NA PROGRAM: As of 21 April 2022, a total of 1,021,014 ROFs were assisted back to their home provinces. Of which, 410,802 were assisted by land, 514,120 by air, and 96,092 by sea.

**OWWA COVID-19 RELATED ASSISTANCE TO OFWs**: From March 2020 to 10 October, 2021, a total of **829,067** OFWs were assisted by OWWA on their "Returned to Home Regions" program and **801,037** OFWs are also assisted through "OFW Kalinga" program.

**RETURNING FILIPINOS (REFs) from SABAH:** As of 22 May 2021, a total of <u>3,289</u> REFs from Sabah had arrived in the country. While as of 21 June 2021, a total of <u>4,683</u> remaining Filipinos are still in Sabah for transfer.
