Summary of Cases³

As of **12 April 2020**, a total of **4,648 confirmed COVID-19 cases** were monitored and reported in the Philippines, of which **297** persons were declared **dead** while **197** persons have already **recovered**.

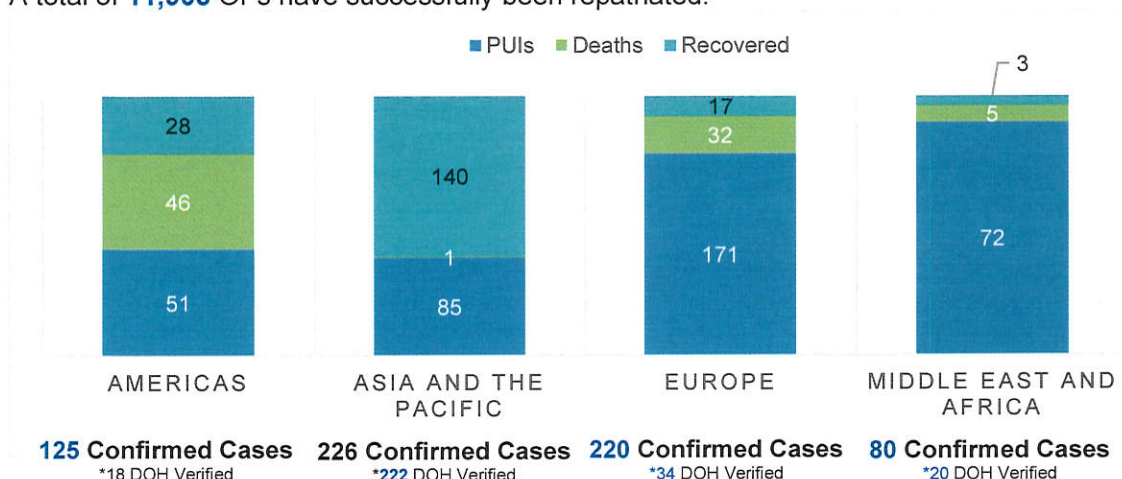

Meanwhile, a breakdown of COVID-19 cases per region is gathered in **ANNEX A**. The source of the data is the Regional DRRMCs. The data needs further validation of DOH Central.

Summary of Effects to Overseas Filipinos⁴

As of **12 April 2020**, around **40** countries have Overseas Filipinos (OFs) with confirmed COVID-19 cases. A total of **654 confirmed COVID-19 cases** for OFs were monitored and reported, of which **84** were declared **dead** while **188** persons have already **recovered**. Meanwhile, a total of **382** persons are considered as **PUIs**. The region of **Asia and the Pacific** has the highest number of confirmed COVID-19 cases for overseas Filipinos (**226 cases**) while the region of **Middle East and Africa** has the lowest number of confirmed cases (**83 cases**).

A total of **11,903** OFs have successfully been repatriated.

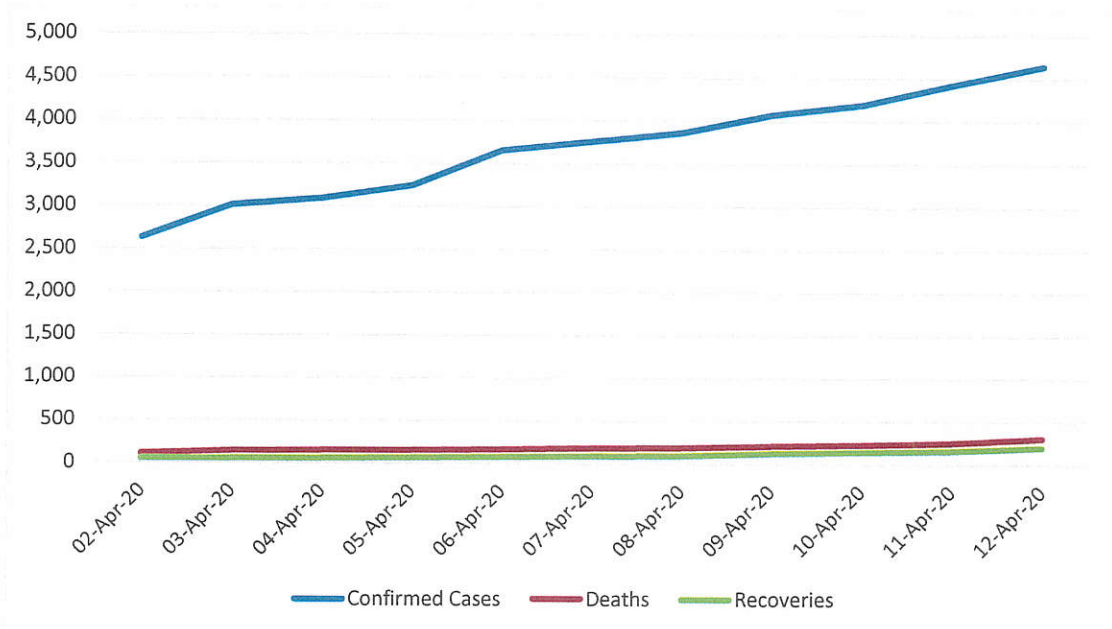


Graph 1 Total COVID-19 cases affecting Overseas Filipinos per region

As of 06 April 2020, a total of 81 provinces, 122 cities and 1,448 municipalities have declared community quarantine.

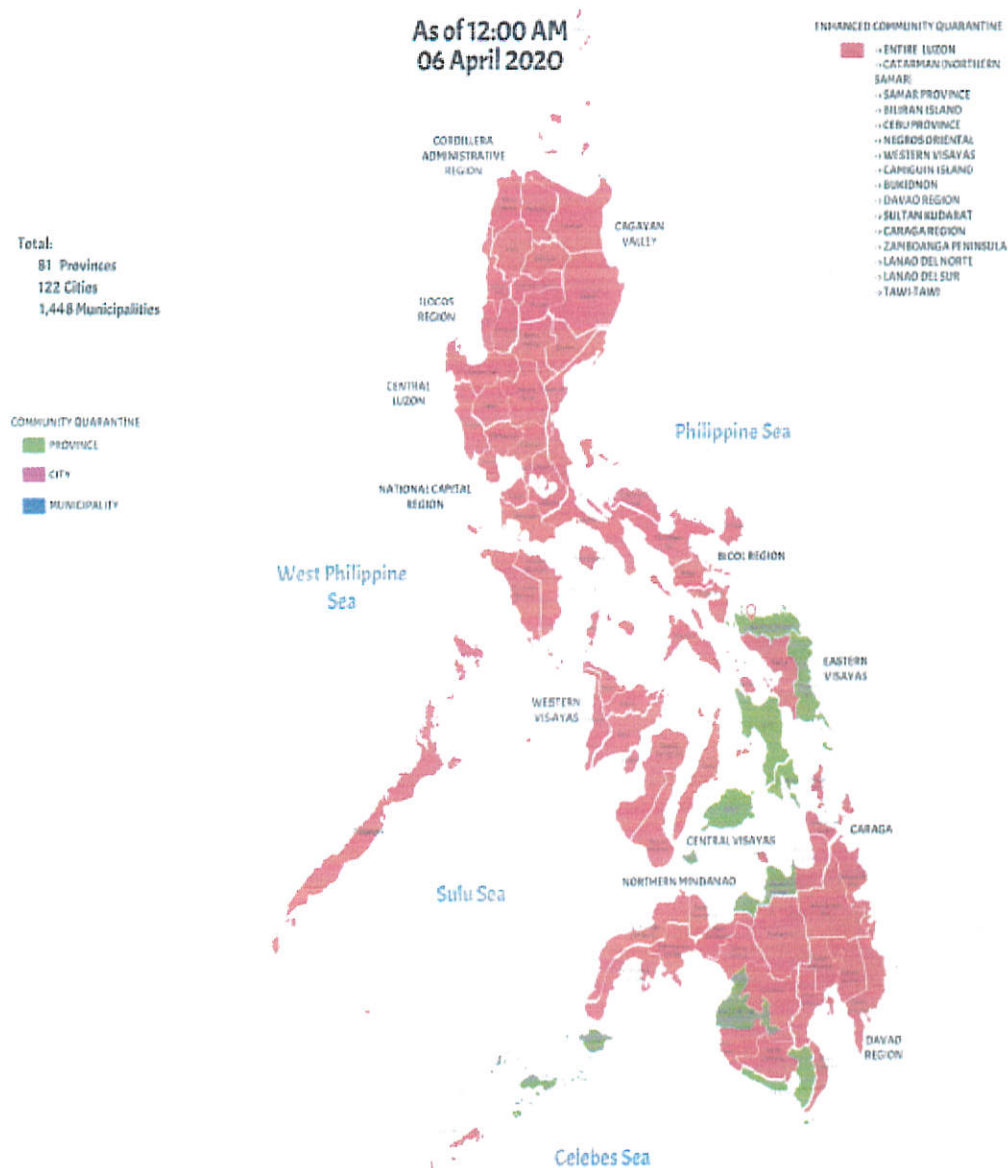


Figure 1 LGUs with community quarantine declarations

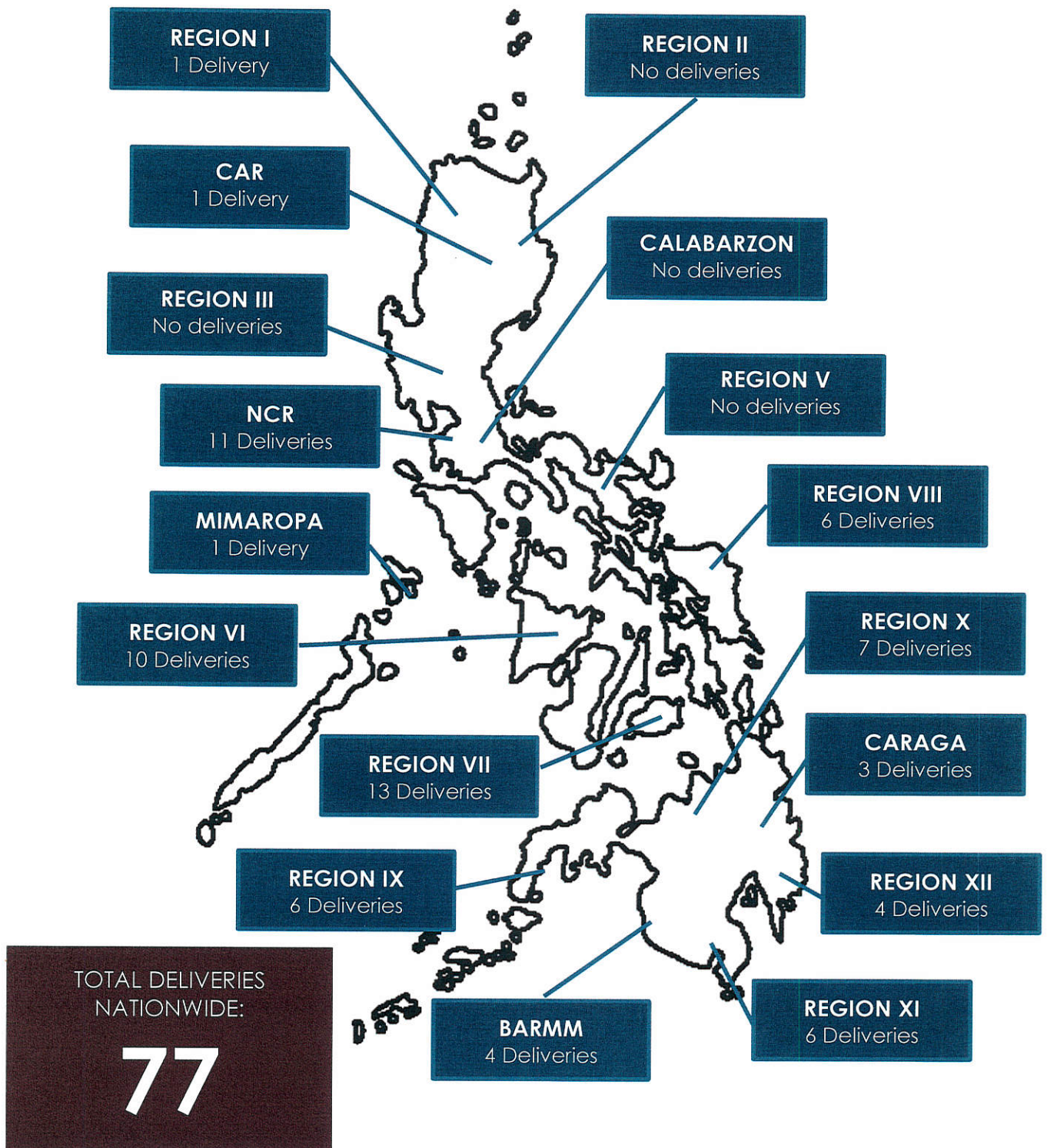


Figure 2 Breakdown of transportation services for the delivery of donations, goods and other items to regions

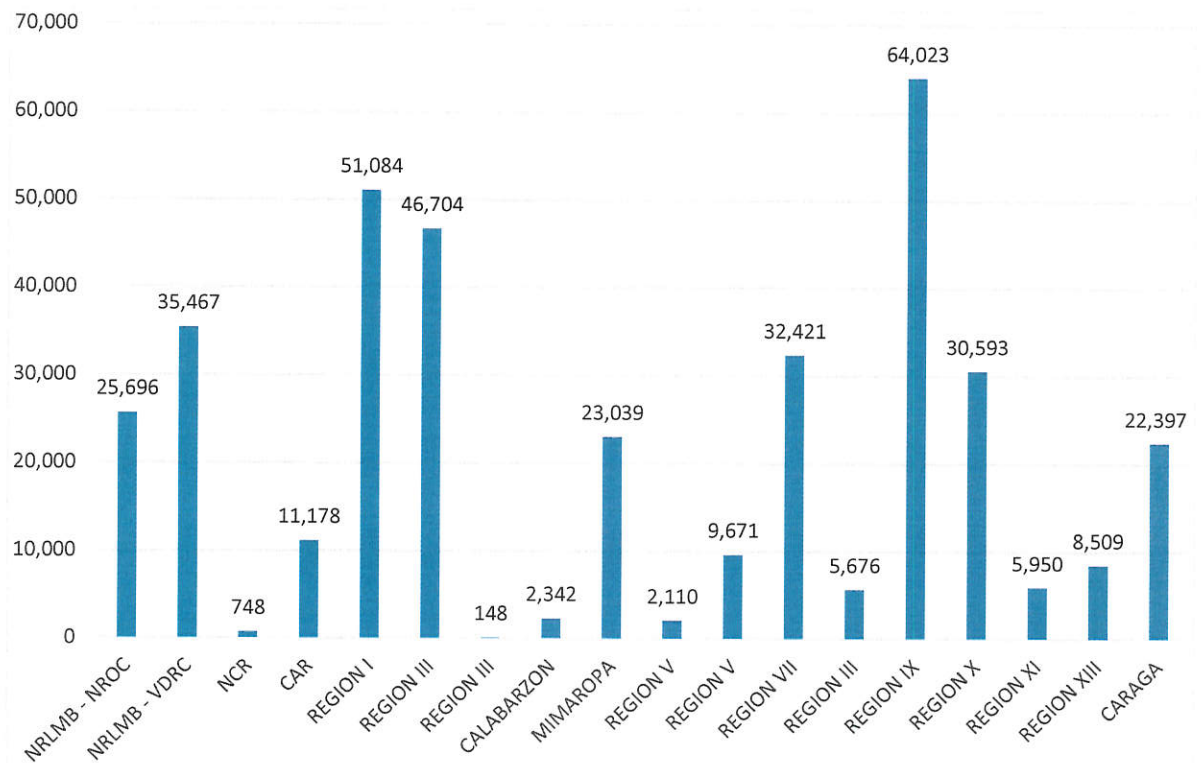

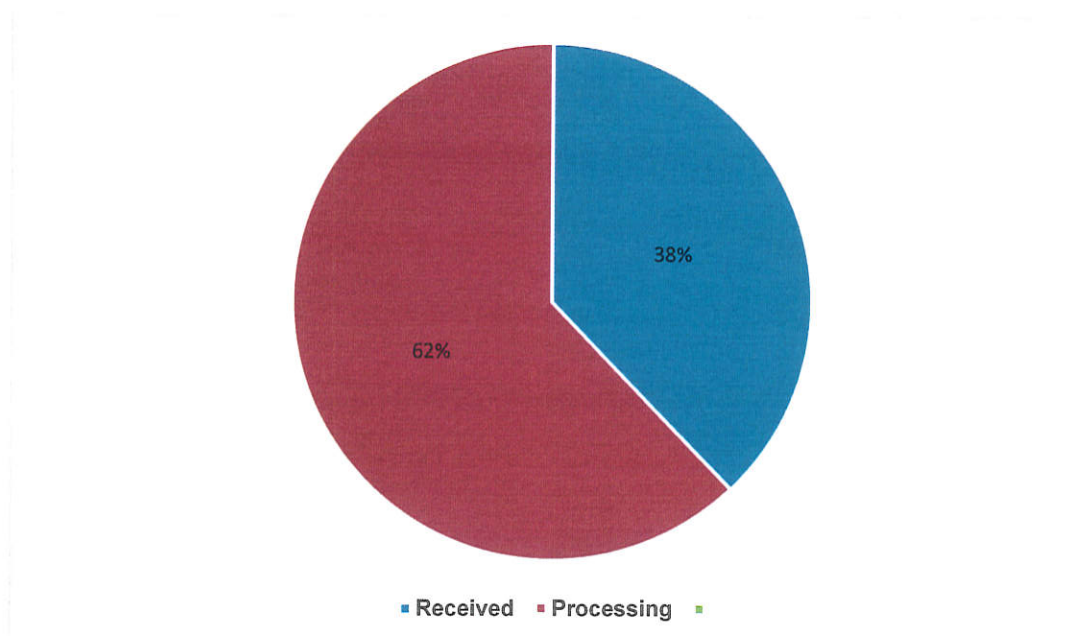
Graph 4 Summary of Stockpiled Family Food packs

Offers of International Assistance¹³

As of 12 April 2020, DFA has processed/assisted in the processing/facilitation of international humanitarian assistance from 4 foreign governments and 3 other entities thereof, 1 international organization, and 18 private companies, groups and individuals. It is also assisting in obtaining flight clearances and in the issuance of visas for foreign technical experts in relation to COVID-19-related procurement of the Philippine Red Cross. Below is the breakdown of the items covered by the international humanitarian assistance / donations to the Philippine Government that have been processed or are currently in process through DFA.

The total number of offers of international assistances accounts to 37. Out of the total offers, 14 or 38% has been received by the Philippines, 62% are currently being processed.
