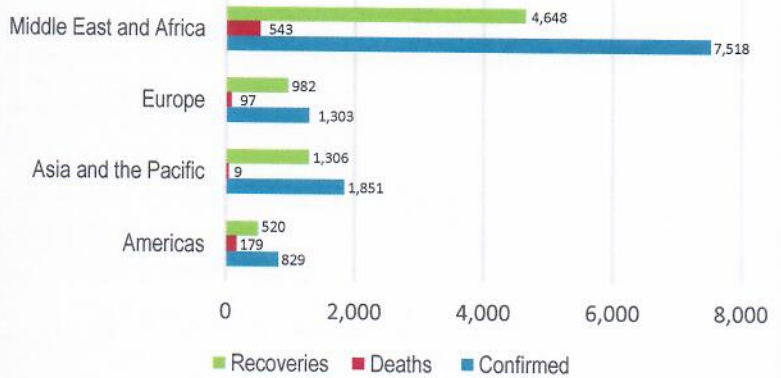

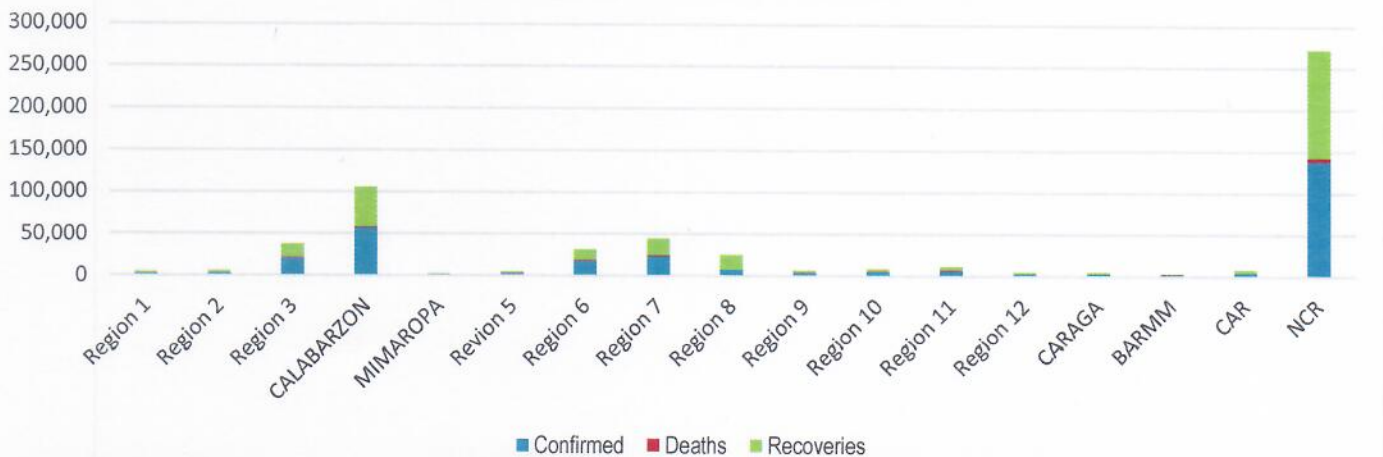
Status of Filipinos Overseas

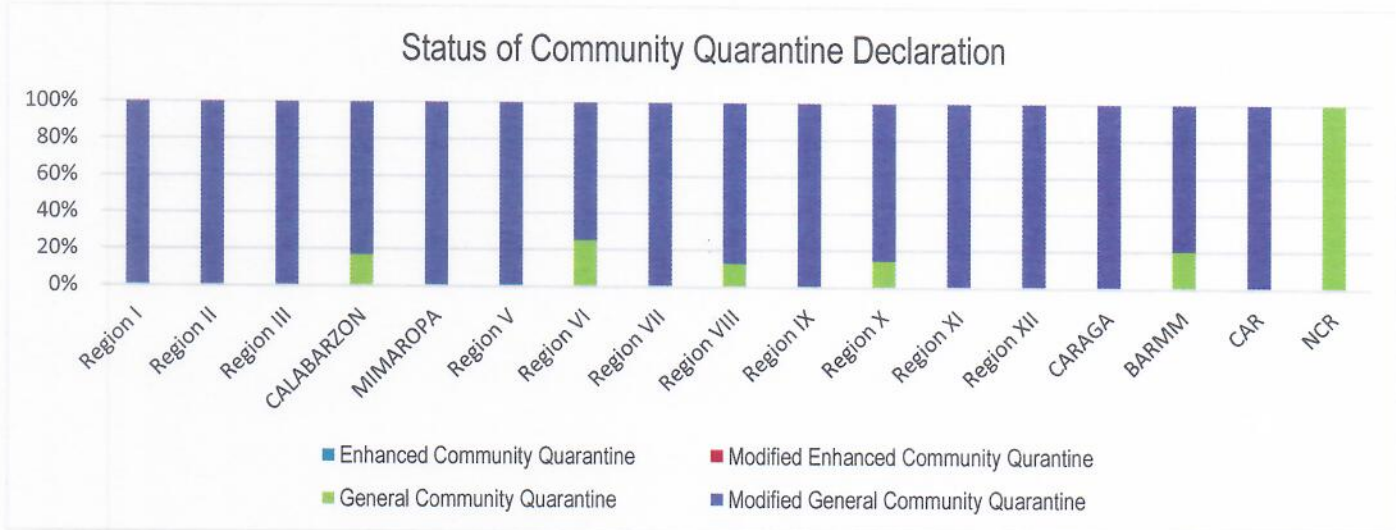


P-D-I-T-R STRATEGY

With reference to the National Action Plan (NAP) for COVID-19, the National Task Force is intensifying efforts to PREVENT the spread of the COVID-19, TEST individuals and communities, ISOLATE those that are identified to be confirmed cases, TREAT and provide with appropriate health care, and REINTEGRATE them back to the community.

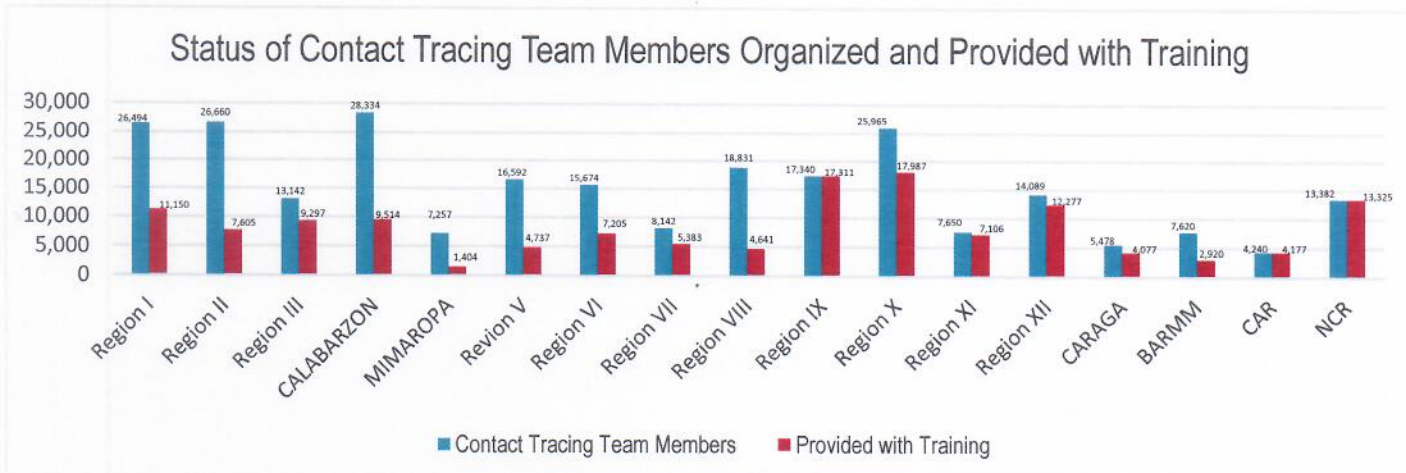
PREVENT

PREVENT enables to change mindsets and behaviors to advocate for a shared responsibility in ensuring compliance to minimum public health standards and protocols and address stigma and division in the communities, workplaces, schools. To implement the PREVENT strategy, community quarantine declarations are made in various localities, enforcing stricter regulations and disease preventive measures particular for areas with high cases. Status of community quarantine declarations is summarized as follows:



DETECT

DETECT entails active screening of those presenting with signs and symptoms of COVID-19 in the community as well as other disease surveillance activities. For this purpose, contact tracing teams have been organized and provided with appropriate training. Summary is as follows:

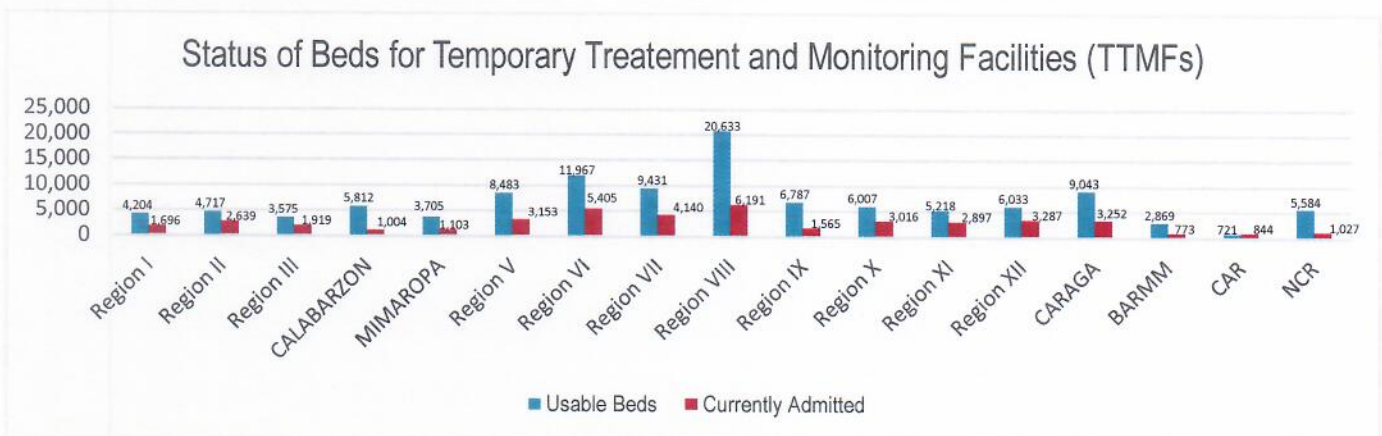

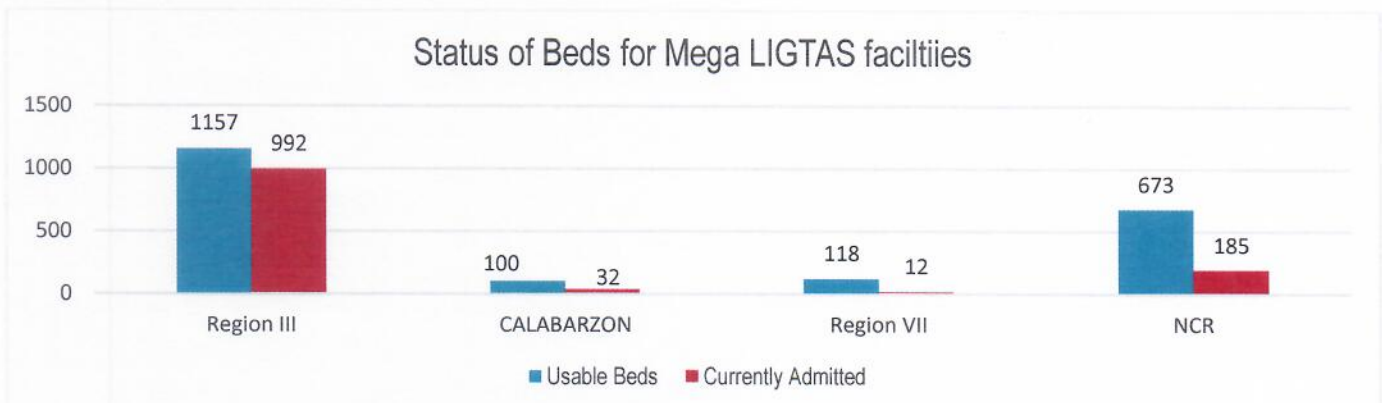

ISOLATE

Isolate involves implementation of measures to separate those identified as exposed and confirmed cases and provide medical interventions to further prevent the spread of the disease. This strategy involves setting up of Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facilities (TTMFs). The summary of TTMFs established is as follows:

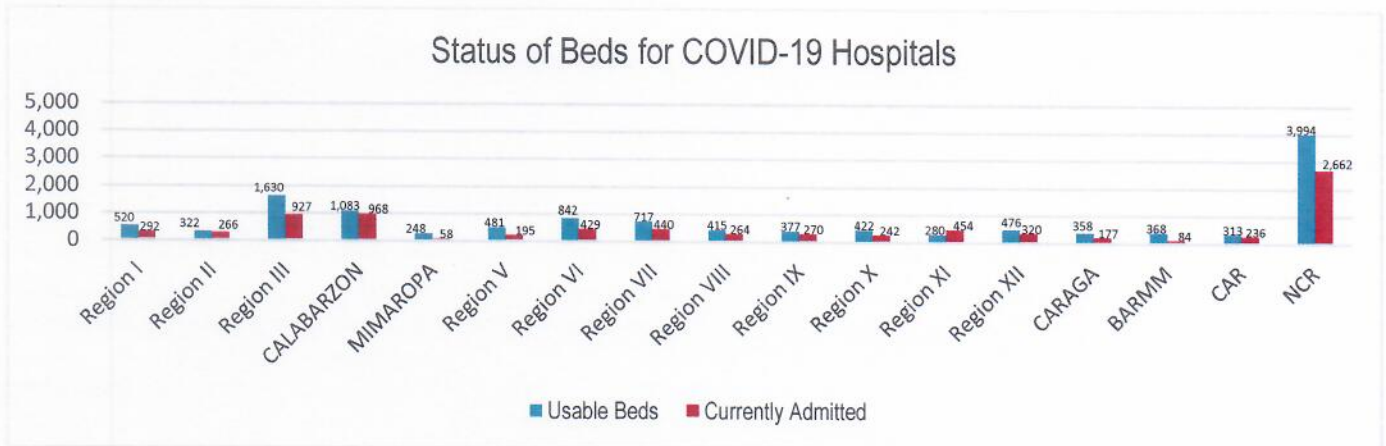

For the TREAT strategy, One Hospital Command has been established to facilitate centralized referral system. Further, wards, isolation and intensive care units are in operation to provide treatment services for COVID-19 positives. In terms of resources, the following is the summary of total domestic donations, international donations received by the Philippine government as well as the total procured personal protective equipment (PPE) distributed.




MANAGEMENT OF RETURNING OVERSEAS FILIPINOS

**NARRATIVE REPORT
10 November 2020**

ACTIONS TAKEN: Management of Returning Overseas Filipinos (MROF)

The Task Group on Management of Returning Overseas Filipinos (TG-MROF) was created by the National Incident Command-National Task Force COVID 19 to solely cater to the medical and social needs of Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs). The TG-MROF in coordination with various government agencies, private entities, and other task groups created to response with the prevailing crisis, regional task units, and local government agencies that are task to facilitate the safe return of the ROFs back to their home provinces.

Members: DND, DOTr, DOLE, DILG, DFA, DOT, DSWD, DOH, OCD, OWWA, BOQ, CAAP, MARINA, PCG, PNP and AFP

ARRIVALS: As of 8 November 2020, a total of 516,960 Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) arrived at the NAIA Terminals 1, 2, and 3, Clark International Airport, Mactan-Cebu International Airport, South Harbor, Subic, Bataan, and Zamboanga Port. Of which, 225,477 are land-based OFWs, 208,228 are sea-based OFWs and 81,222 are Non-OFWs.

A total of 2,033 deceased OFs had arrived in the country from 01 July – 9 November 2020. Of which, 318 died due to COVID-19.

TESTING: As of 8 November 2020, a total of 514,927 ROFs were all tested thru RT-PCR. Of which, 12,987 ROFs that was previously tested thru Rapid Test Kits have undergone a re-test thru RT-PCR.

QUARANTINE: As of 9 November 2020, a total of 10,020 ROFs were confirmed positive with COVID-19. Of which, 500 are admitted at 15 quarantine facilities, 9,406 were able to recover and 5 died.

As of 04 August 2020, a total of 642 Non-OFWs under quarantine in 141 Accommodation Establishments (AEs) in NCR.

DEPARTURES: As of 1 November 2020, TG-MROF was able to assist 221,963 ROFs back to their home provinces. Of which, 77,499 were assisted by land, 139,574 by air, and 4,890 by sea.

ASSISTANCE: As of 24 September 2020, a total of 333,985 OFWs were assisted thru OWWA. Of which, 151,017 were assisted through the "Hatid-sundo" Program, 156,378 through the "OFW Kalinga" Program, 7,123 were assisted through the "Tulong Marino" Program and 19,467 assistances to stranded OFWs in the region.

RETURNING FILIPINOS (REFs) from SABAH: As of 30 September 2020, a total of 1,963 REFs from Sabah arrived in the country and were assisted to go back in their home provinces.

MORATORIUM: As of 17 October 2020, a total of 4 areas in Region VI and BARMM had temporarily suspended the acceptance of ROFs and LSIs.
