






### P-D-I-T-R STRATEGY

With reference to the National Action Plan (NAP) for COVID-19, the National Task Force is intensifying efforts to PREVENT the spread of the COVID-19, TEST individuals and communities, ISOLATE those that are identified to be confirmed cases, TREAT and provide with appropriate health care, and REINTEGRATE them back to the community.

### PREVENT

PREVENT enables to change mindsets and behaviors to advocate for a shared responsibility in ensuring compliance to minimum public health standards and protocols and address stigma and division in the communities, workplaces, schools. To implement the PREVENT strategy, community quarantine declarations are made in various localities, enforcing stricter regulations and disease preventive measures particular for areas with high cases. Status of community quarantine declarations is summarized as follows:



### DETECT

DETECT entails active screening of those presenting with signs and symptoms of COVID-19 in the community as well as other disease surveillance activities. For this purpose, contact tracing teams have been organized and provided with appropriate training. Summary is as follows:





### **ISOLATE**

Isolate involves implementation of measures to separate those identified as exposed and confirmed cases and provide medical interventions to further prevent the spread of the disease. This strategy involves setting up of Temporary Treatment and Monitoring Facilities (TTMFs). The summary of TTMFs established is as follows:




Aside from the TTMFs, Mega LIGTAS facilities have also been established. The summary of occupancies for the Mega LIGTAS facilities is as follows:



### TREAT

For the TREAT strategy, One Hospital Command has been established to facilitate centralized referral system. Further, wards, isolation and intensive care units are in operation to provide treatment services for COVID-19 positives. The occupancy rate for all beds dedicated to COVID-19 (Ward, Isolation, Intensive Care) among reporting hospitals is summarized as follows.

### Task Group on Management of Returning Overseas Filipinos

#### NARRATIVE REPORT 9 December 2020

ACTIONS TAKEN: Management of Returning Overseas Filipinos (MROF)

The Task Group on Management of Returning Overseas Filipinos (TG-MROF) was created by the National Incident Command-National Task Force COVID 19 to solely cater to the medical and social needs of Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs). The TG-MROF in coordination with various government agencies, private entities, and other task groups created to respo nse with the prevailing crisis, regional task units, and local government agencies that are task to facilitate the safe return of the ROFs back to their home provinces.

**Members:** DND, DOTr, DOLE, DILG, DFA, DOT, DSWD, DOH, OCD, OWWA, BOQ, CAAP, MARINA, PCG, PNP and AFP

ARRIVALS: As of 7 December 2020, a total of <u>633,626</u> Returning Overseas Filipinos (ROFs) arrived at the NAIA Terminals 1, 2, and 3, Clark International Airport, Mactan-Cebu International Airport, South Harbor, Subic, Bataan, and Zamboanga Port. Of which, <u>282,020</u> are land-based OFWs,218 <u>243,230</u> are sea-based OFWs and <u>106,118</u> are Non-OFWs.

A total of <u>2,258</u> deceased OFs had arrived in the country from 01 July – 8 December 2020. Of which, <u>331</u> died due to COVID-19.A

**TESTING**: As of 7 December 2020, a total of <u>631,728</u> ROFs were all tested thru RT-PCR. Of which, <u>12,987</u> ROFs that was previously tested thru Rapid Test Kits have undergone a re-test thru RT-PCR.

QUARANTINE: As of 8 December 2020, a total of <u>11,246</u> ROFs were confirmed positive with COVID-19. Of which, <u>432</u> are admitted at <u>17</u> quarantine facilities, <u>10,793</u> were able to recover and <u>6</u> died.

As of 04 August 2020, a total of <u>642</u> Non-OFWs under quarantine in <u>141</u> Accommodation Establishments (AEs) in NCR.

**DEPARTURES**: As of 06 December 2020, TG-MROF was able to assist <u>338,305</u> ROFs back to their home provinces. Of which, <u>99,471</u> were assisted by land, <u>172,187</u> by air, and <u>59,219</u> by sea.

**ASSISTANCE**: As of 15 November 2020, a total of <u>534,159</u> OFWs were assisted thru OWWA. Of which, <u>251,104</u> were assisted through the "Hatid-sundo" Program, <u>256,465</u> through the "OFW Kalinga" Program, <u>7,123</u> were assisted through the "Tulong Marino" Program and assistances to stranded OFWs in the region.

**RETURNING FILIPINOS (REFs) from SABAH:** As of 30 September 2020, a total of <u>1,963</u> REFs from Sabah arrived in the country and were assisted to go back in their home provinces.

**MORATORIUM:** As of 24 November 2020, a total of <u>4 areas</u> in Region VI and BARMM had temporarily suspended the acceptance of ROFs and LSIs.
