Summary of Cases³

As of **10 April 2020**, a total of **4,195** confirmed COVID-19 cases were monitored and reported in the Philippines, of which **221** persons were declared **dead** while **140** persons have already **recovered**.



Summary of Effects to Overseas Filipinos⁴

As of **10 April 2020**, around **39** countries have Overseas Filipinos (OFs) with confirmed COVID-19 cases. A total of **607** confirmed COVID-19 cases for OFs were monitored and reported, of which **72** were declared **dead** while **171** persons have already **recovered**. Meanwhile, a total of **364** persons are considered as **PUIs**. The region of **Asia and the Pacific** has the highest number of confirmed COVID-19 cases for overseas Filipinos (**226 cases**) while the region of **Middle East and Africa** has the lowest number of confirmed cases (**62 cases**).


A total of **10,840** OFs have successfully been repatriated.

As of 06 April 2020, a total of 81 provinces, 122 cities and 1,448 municipalities have declared community quarantine.





Figure 1 LGUs with community quarantine declarations

Delivery of Government Procured PPEs⁷

The NDRRMC Emergency Operations Center (EOC), managed by the Office of Civil Defense (OCD), facilitated the delivery of PPEs procured by the national government. A total of **67, 560 sets of PPEs** were distributed in **five (5) batches**. Below is the summary of the distribution.

The recipients of the PPEs were located in Regions I, III, IVA, V and majority in NCR. A master flight plan was developed by OCD to cater the delivery of the PPEs in other parts of the country.

In addition, OCD facilitated the requests of other offices and organizations to transport various items ranging from PPEs, medical supplies, testing kits and other goods relevant to COVID-19 response.

As of **10 April 2020**, total of **132** requests were received, 74 or 56% of which have been completed.





As of **11 April 2020**, a total of **387,457** family food packs are stockpiled in the DSWD warehouses nationwide.




Graph 4 Summary of Stockpiled Family Food packs

Offers of International Assistance¹⁴

As of **10 April 2020**, the Department of Foreign Affairs (DFA) has processed/assisted in the facilitation of donations from 4 foreign governments, 1 international organization, and 15 private companies and individuals. Most of the assistance provided were testing kits, PPEs and other medical supplies.

The total number of offers of international assistances accounts to **35**. Out of the total offers, **14 or 40%** has been received by the Philippines, **60%** are currently being processed.
