MODERATE TO STRONG NORTHEASTERLY WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

SEABOARDS	WEATHER	WIND FORCE (KPH /KNOTS)	SEA CONDITION	WAVE HEIGHT (meters)
THE NORTHERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON (Batanes, Calayan, Northern Coast of Cagayan including Babuyan Islands, and Ilocos Norte)	Mostly lousy skies with isolated light rains	36 - 52 / 19 - 28	Moderate to Rough	2.1 to 3.4
THE WESTERN SEABOARD OF NORTHERN LUZON (Western Coast of Ilocos Norte)	Partly cloudy skies with isolated rainshowers or thunderstorms	36 - 52 / 19 - 28	Moderate to Rough	2.1 to 3.4
