PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 PM TODAY, THE EYE OF TYPHOON "AMBO" (VONGFONG) WAS LOCATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA IN THE VICINITY OF MASLOG, EASTERN SAMAR (12.1°N, 125.2 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 155 KM/H NEAR THE CANTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 255 KM/H. IT IS MOVING TOWARDS THE WEST AT 15 KM/H.

NORTHERN SAMAR - particularly Catarman, Bugko, Pambujan, Catubig, Palapag, Mawo, and Gamay. SOUTHERN LEYTE - particularly Bisay, Himbangan, and Pandan. SAMAR - particularly Basey, Silanga, Calbiga, and Jibatan. BILIRAN - all rivers and its tributaries

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above-mentioned river systems and the <u>LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCILS</u> concerned are advised to be to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and

reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Moreover, you are hereby directed to reiterate the guidelines on personal protection and hygiene such as respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene, social distancing, environmental, and food safety measures.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
