### SITUATION OVERVIEW

The Low Pressure Area (LPA) over Mindanao has dissipated. However, the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) will continue to bring cloudy skies with scattered light to moderate rains and isolated thunderstorms over Western and Central Visayas, Zamboanga Peninsula, Northern Mindanao, and Palawan.

With this development, this is the final advisory for the aforementioned weather systems.

You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions as necessary.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
