### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

At 8:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 280 km East Northeast of Davao City or 220 km East Southeast of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (7.9°N, 128.3°E) embedded along the Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ). The combined effect of the LPA and the ITCZ will bring scattered light to moderate with occasional heavy rains over Mindanao, Visayas, and pBicol Region.

Residents in the aforementioned areas, especially those living in highly susceptible to flooding and rain-induced landslides are advised to take appropriate actions, coordinate with the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Offices (LDRRMOs), and continue monitoring for updates including the thunderstorms or rainfall advisories, and heavy rainfall warnings issued by the PAGASA Regional Services Division.

### **II. ACTIONS TAKEN:**

NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 01** to OCD Regional Offices **V, VI, VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, CARAGA, and BARMM** through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
