### **I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:**

At 11:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 635 km East of Davao City (7.3°N, 131.6°E). This weather disturbance is likely to develop into a Tropical Depression within 48 hours and it will be named "AMBO". Moreover, it is forecast to bring scattered light to moderate with occasional heavy rains over the regions of CARAGA, Davao, and SOCCSKSARGEN.

Residents in the aforementioned areas, especially those living in highly susceptible to flooding and rain-induced landslides are advised to take appropriate actions, coordinate with the Local Disaster Risk Reduction And Management Offices (LDRRMC), and continue monitoring for updates including the thunderstorms or rainfall advisories, and heavy rainfall warnings issued by the PAGASA Regional Services Division.

The next update on this weather disturbance will be incorporated in the 24-hour Public Weather Forecast to be issued at 4:00 PM today and 4:00 AM tomorrow.

The next Weather Advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow.


You are hereby directed to monitor the situation and undertake precautionary measures in your area of responsibility (AOR). Likewise, the public and the DRRMCs are advised to take appropriate actions as necessary.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualties.
