The Low Pressure Area (LPA) East of Mindanao has developed into Tropical Depression “AMBO”.

- The LPA developed into a TD over the Philippine Sea East of Mindanao at 2:00 PM today.
- In the next 24 hours, the trough of TD “AMBO” will bring scattered light to moderate with isolated heavy rains during thunderstorms over CARAGA, Davao Region, SOCCSKSARGEN, and Maguindanao. Residents in these areas are advised to continue monitoring for updates, especially the local rainfall or thunderstorm advisories and heavy rainfall warnings of PAGASA Regional Services Division (PRSD).
- The raising of Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal in any locality of the country remains less likely in the next 48 hours.

Location of eye/center:	At 4:00 PM today, the center of Tropical Depression “AMBO” was estimated based on all available data at 545 km East of Hinatuan, Surigao del Sur (7.6°N, 131.2°E) .
Strength:	Maximum sustained winds of up to 45 km/h near the center and gustiness of up to 55 km/h .
Movement:	Moving West Northwest at 15 km/h
