I. SITUATION OVERVIEW:

At 11:00 AM today, the Low Pressure Area (LPA) was estimated based on all available data at 635 km East of Davao City (7.3°N, 131.6°E). This weather disturbance is likely to develop into a Tropical Depression within 48 hours and it will be named "AMBO". Moreover, it is forecast to bring scattered light to moderate with occasional heavy rains over the regions of CARAGA, Davao, and SOCCSKSARGEN.

Residents in the aforementioned areas, especially those living in highly susceptible to flooding and rain-induced landslides are advised to take appropriate actions, coordinate with the Local Disaster Risk Reduction And Management Offices (LDRRMC), and continue monitoring for updates including the thunderstorms or rainfall advisories, and heavy rainfall warnings issued by the PAGASA Regional Services Division.

The next update on this weather disturbance will be incorporated in the 24-hour Public Weather Forecast to be issued at 4:00 PM today and 4:00 AM tomorrow.

The next Weather Advisory will be issued at 11:00 AM tomorrow.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN:

NDRRM Operations Center disseminated **Weather Advisory No. 01** to OCD Regional Offices **I, II, III, CALABARZON, MIMAROPA, V, VI VII, VIII, IX, X, XI, XII, CARAGA, BARMM, CAR and NCR** through SMS and facsimile and uploaded on the NDRRMC website for further dissemination to their respective local DRRMCs from the provincial down to the municipal levels.
