**"AMBO" WEAKENS INTO A LOW PRESSURE AREA WHILE MOVING
GENERALLY NORTHEASTWARD OVER THE BASHI CHANNEL.**

- Tropical Cyclone Wind Signal No. 1 over Batanes is now lifted.
- Until tonight, light to moderate with at times heavy rains over Batanes.
- Moderate to rough seas will be experienced over Batanes and Babuyan Islands. Fisherfolks and those with small seacrafts are advised not to venture out on these areas.

Location of eye/center:	At 4:00 PM today , the center of LPA "AMBO" was estimated based on all available data at 125 km Northwest of Basco, Batanes (21.3°N, 121.2°E) .
Movement:	Moving
