I. Initial Report regarding Moderate to Heavy Rains in Sultan Kudarat (Region XII)

A. Situation Overview

On 5-6 June 2020, moderate to heavy rains were experienced in Bagumbayan, Sultan Kudarat due to localized thunderstorms.

B. Effects

- A total of 140 families/farmers were affected.
- A total of 54 houses were flooded.
- The incident also resulted to damage to infrastructure particularly to road networks as well as damage to rice fields in 12 barangays in Bagumbayan, Sultan Kudarat.

C. Actions Taken

- PDRRMO Sultan Kudarat conducted ocular visit to affected areas and distributed food packs to affected families.
- MDRRMC Bagumbayan conducted validation and damage assessment.
- Bagumbayan Municipal Agriculture Office still conducting assessment to damage rice fields.
- Bagumbayan Municipal Engineering Office still conducting assessment to damage road networks
- LGU Bagumbayan initially distributed rice assistance and food packs to the affected families.
- BDRRMCs of affected barangays conducted initial damage assessment.

II. Initial Report Re: Flooding Due to Continuous Rainfall in Sarangani Province (Region XII)

A. Situation Overview

On 07 June 2020, around 11:00AM to 5:00PM, moderate to heavy rainfall due to localized thunderstorms was experienced in Kiamba, Sarangani Province. As a result, Nalus River and Sawagen River in Barangay Nalus swelled which brought flooding to the municipality.

B. Effects

- A total of 100 families in Purok Christmas, Purok Masagana, Purok Narra and Purok Yakal of Barangay Nalus were affected.
- The incident resulted to landslide in Km 1, Km 3 and Km 4 which rendered the barangay road unpassable for motor vehicles going to Purok Green Valley.
- One (1) house was partially damaged due to mudslide.
- No reported casualties.

C. Actions Taken

- BDRRMC with MDRRMO conducted evacuation but families refused and opted to stay in their house.
 - MDRRMC Kiamba conducted Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis.
