I. Progress Report re Flooding and Landslide Incident in Kiamba, Sarangani Province (Region XII)

A. Situation Overview

On 7-8 June 2020, moderate to heavy rainfall was experienced in the Municipality of Kiamba, Sarangani Province due to localized thunderstorms brought by the prevailing Intertropical Convergence Zone (ITCZ) which resulted to the swelling of Nalus and Sawagen River, and localized flooding.

B. Effects

- A landslide incident occurred in Brgys. Nalus, Suli and Badtasan while a flooding incident occurred in 6 barangays due to the incident.
- A total of 121 families were affected and stayed in the evacuation centers while others opted to stay with their relatives.
- A total of 13 houses (3 partially / 10 totally) were damaged.
- The following damaged to infrastructure were reported:
 - ✓ A footbridge in Brgy Suli,
 - ✓ Farm to Market Road Km 1 to Km 4 in Brgy. Nalus
 - ✓ Barangay Road Network in Brgy. Tamadag
- On-going assessment on the estimated cost of damage to agriculture and infrastructure.

C. Actions Taken

- DSWD XII distributed foodpacks to the affected families.
- MDRRMC Kiamba conducted Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis.

- LGU Kiamba distributed building materials and relief goods to the affected families.
 - Kiamba Municipal Agriculture Office conducted assessment on the estimated cost of damage while Municipal Engineering Office conducted assessment on damaged infrastructure.
 - BDRRMC with MDRRMO conducted evacuation but families refused and opted to stay in their house.
