### **Progress Report re Maritime Incident in Occidental Mindoro (MIMAROPA)**

#### **A. Situation Overview**

- At 5:30 PM, 29 June 2020, a collision incident transpired at La Playa Resort, Tayamaan, Mamburao, Occidental Mindoro involving MV Veinna Wood Alpha Hong Kong flagged cargo vessel bound for Australia from Subic, Zambales and a fishing boat (FBCA) "Liberty 5". Search and rescue teams were deployed to conduct SAR operations.

#### **B. Effects**

- A total of fourteen (14) persons onboard Liberty 5 were reportedly trapped inside the compartment. To date, said passengers are still reported missing.

#### **C. Actions Taken**

##### **OCD MIMAROPA**

- Continuous coordination with PCG Station Mamburao regarding updates on the Search and Rescue Operations.

##### **PCG and PAF**

- Conducted aerial survey over the site of the maritime incident.

##### **PCG**

- Deployed scuba divers to conduct search and rescue operations.

### **Initial Report re Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Davao del Sur Province (Region XI)**

#### **A. Situation Overview**

- At 7:30PM, 28 June 2020, Davao del Sur experienced moderate to rains due to the localized thunderstorms. The sustained heavy rain showers resulted to

flooding in some barangays in Digos City and the municipality of Sta. Cruz with inundation reaching up to an approximate height of two (2) meters.

- A landslide incident was also reported in Sitio Terin, Brgy. Kapatagan, Digos City.

#### **B. Effects**

- A total of 540 families or 1,885 persons were displaced.
- A total of eight (8) damaged houses in Sta. Cruz, Davao del Sur.
- No reported casualties

#### **C. Actions Taken**

##### **OCD XI**

- Conducted continuous monitoring of AOR for any incident caused by heavy rains.
- Continuous dissemination of weather update and advisories to all LDRRMCs thru email, Telefax and Social Media.
- Conducted continuous coordination with CDRRMC Digos City and PDRRMC Davao del Sur.

##### **PDRRMO Davao del Sur**

- Deployed Response Operation Team at Barangay Igpit, Digos City.
- Conducted close monitoring of the incident.

##### **CDRRMO Digos City, Davao del Sur**

- Deployed the Digos Emergency Response Team together with PNP and BFP to conduct force evacuation of the affected families in the flashflood area.
- CSWDO and CDRRMO visited and assessed the affected families at the evacuation center.

##### **PDRRMO Davao Occidental**

- Deployed eight (8) members of the PDRRMO Davao Occidental response team in providing assistance to immediately evacuate the affected families in Digos City.

##### **MDRRMRCs Kiblawan, Malalag and Sulop**

- Deployed Response Operation Team to the affected areas in Digos City.

##### **Davao Firefighters Rescue Services**

- Augmented response team to conduct response operations to flooded affected areas in Digos City.

##### **MDRRMC Sta. Cruz**

- Conducted pre-emptive evacuation to the affected families.
- Conducted Response Operation to the affected families of the flashflood incident.
- Affected families were referred to MSWD Office for financial assistance.
