I. SITUATION OVERVIEW

STATUS OF KANLAON VOLCANO

DOST-PHIVOLCS is currently monitoring an ongoing series of earthquakes on the west lower flanks of Kanlaon Volcano, Negros Island. **This began at 4:03 PM, 21 June 2020 with the largest registering at M4.7 at 1:15 AM today and was felt at Intensity V at La Carlota City. As of this time, a total of 81 events have been recorded.**

DOST-PHIVOLCS would like to assure the public especially the local communities surrounding Kanlaon that they are keeping close watch of the condition of the volcano and shall inform all concerned immediately should there be any further developments.

II. ACTIONS TAKEN

1. NDRRM Operations Center prepared NDRRMC Advisory and Update, and disseminated the same to **OCD Regional Center VI** through NDRRMC website in order to closely monitor the situation and take appropriate actions for any new development.
2. Concerned NDRRMC member-agencies were provided with a copy of the Memorandum for the SND.
3. DOST-PHIVOLCS is closely monitoring the activities of Kanlaon Volcano and any new development will be relayed to all concerned.
