I. Progress Report on Maritime Incident re Collision of MV Vienna Wood and Fishing Boat "Liberty 5" in Mamburao, Occidental Mindoro (MIMAROPA)

A. Situation Overview

28 June 2020

- At 1:00 AM, the "Liberty 5", a fishing vessel owned by Irma Fishing Trading Inc. based in Dagat-Dagatan, Malabon City with 14 crews and passengers onboard, allegedly collided with MV Vienna Wood (a cargo ship registered in Hongkong with Chinese crew) causing Liberty 5 boat to capsize. The incident happened approximately 15 nautical miles from the shorelines of Mamburao, Occidental Mindoro. The cause of collision is yet to determine as the investigation of the Philippine Coast Guard is still on-going.
- The management of Irma Fishing Trading only learned of the incident when one of its fishing boats, FB Wacky, arrived in the vicinity of Cape Calavite in Mamburao where the collision occurred and noticed a floating broken piece of wood with "Liberty 5" written on it.

1 July 2020

- **At 12:00 PM, BRP Malapascua was positioned at latitude 13 degrees 24.424 N, longitude 120 degrees 24.142 E or at vicinity 600 yards S off Paluan Bay shoreline, Occidental Mindoro. Anchored at vicinity waters off Paluan Bay, Occidental Mindoro and conducting coastal search at Paluan Bay using workboat.**
- **At 2:00 PM, coast Guard Mobile Post Mamburao Search and Rescue Team onboard borrowed motorbanca CARMEN-ED 3 continues conduct of SAR operation.**
- **At 3:50 PM, MCI Team headed by Captain Belesario PCG boarded MV Vienna Woods for follow up inquiry on the said vessel's collision with MFB "Liberty 5".**

B. Effects

- On 1 July 2020, a total of 14 crew members of Liberty 5 were reported missing. Most of the crews were from Cuyo, Magsaysay and Araceli, Palawan and the chieftmate was from Aklan while 2 passengers were from Cuyo, Palawan.
- No survivor has been found.

C. Actions Taken

OCD MIMAROPA

- Coordinated with **PCG Southern Tagalog**, PDRRMO Occidental Mindoro, PCG Station Mamburao re Updates on the SAR Operations.
- Deployed the Rigid Hull Inflatable Boat to support the on-going SAR operations for the missing crews.

PCG and 505th Search and Rescue Group, PAF

- Conducted continuous Search and Rescue operations together with local response teams.

OCD Field Office Palawan

- Facilitated the check-in of 505th Search and Rescue Group, PAF as Search and Rescue Team for the said incident with PDRRMO Occidental Mindoro.
- Coordinated with PDRRMO Palawan for actions taken regarding the incident.
- Coordinated with PCG Palawan for incident report.
- Submitted initial report to Regional Director, OCD MIMAROPA.

PDRRMO PALAWAN

- Verified the incident with the Philippine Coast Guard District, Palawan.
- Informed and coordinated the MDRRMOs Magsaysay, Araceli and Cuyo about the incident involving their constituents.
- Closely monitored and coordinated with PCG Palawan re ongoing search and rescue operations.

II. Progress Report on Flooding Incidents re the Effects of Localized Thunderstorms in Davao del Sur Province (Region XI)

A. Situation Overview

- *On 30 June 2020, a flooding incident occurred in the six (6) barangays within the Municipality of Hagonoy. A sudden rise of water level in Balutakay River was observed on evening of 28 June 2020. Thus, constant monitoring was conducted. The continuous heavy rains ensued an evacuation followed by relief operations to the affected residents.*

B. Effects

- A total of **2,800 families or 12,370 individuals** were displaced.
- A total of **15 damaged houses (11 totally, 4 partially)** in Sta. Cruz and Hagonoy, Davao del Sur were reported.

- A total of 2 river dikes were partially damaged in Brgy. Cebulan and Astorga, Sta. Cruz, Davao Del Sur.
- No reported casualties.

C. Actions Taken

OCD MIMAROPA

- Continuously monitored the AOR for any incident caused by heavy rains due to Localized Thunderstorms.

DSWD XI

- Coordinated with Disaster Response Operation Management Information Center (DROMIC) and the City Social Welfare Development Office.
- Conducted profiling and assessment of the affected families.
- Provided 89 sleeping kits, hot meals, blankets, drinking water, facemasks, biscuits, coffee, and milk to the residents currently staying in the evacuation areas.

PNP Hagonoy

- Assisted in the conduct of Search and Rescue Operations.
- Provided security and safety for the evacuees.
- Provided Municipal PNP Patrol car to rescue the affected individuals.

MDRRMC Sta. Cruz

- *Conducted Response Operation and pre-emptive evacuation of the affected families.*
- *Gathered additional data from the BDRRMC for validation and dissemination.*
- *Conducted strict implementation on crowd control management and order at headquarters.*
- *Dispatched all MDRRMO Personnel at the different areas within the AOR and conducted routine monitoring at identified flooded areas.*

III. Final Report re Fire Incident in Hayes St., Brgy 40, Cagayan de Oro City (Region X)

A. Situation Overview

- At 3:00 PM, 01 July 2020, a fire incident happened in Hayes St., Brgy, 40, Cagayan de Oro City involving residential houses and commercial establishments. Fire out was declared at 4:00 PM on the same day. The cause of fire is still under investigation.

B. Effects

- No casualties were reported while a total of 20 persons were affected and are staying with their relatives.
- A total of 7 houses were totally damaged, of which, the estimated cost of damage amounted to ₱3,060,000.00.

C. Actions Taken

- OCD X prepared report and monitored the said incident.
 - City Fire Department BFP-X responded to the incident.
 - CSWD Cagayan De Oro City distributed food items.
