**Progress Report on Flooding Incidents re Effects of Localized Thunderstorms  
in Davao del Sur Province (Region XI)**

**A. Situation Overview**

- At 7:30PM, 28 June 2020, Davao del Sur experienced moderate to rains due to the localized thunderstorms. The sustained heavy rain showers resulted to flooding in some barangays of Digos City and Sta. Cruz municipality with inundation reaching up to an approximate height of two (2) meters.
- A landslide incident was also reported that occurred in Sitio Terin, Brgy. Kapatagan, Digos City.

**B. Effects**

- On 29 June 2020, a total of 13 families were affected by the flashflood that swept the houses of residents living along the low-lying areas which have been identified by the MGB XI as susceptible and prone to flooding.
- On 30 June 2020, there are no reported casualties due to the flooding incident.
- A total of 540 families or 1,945 were displaced due to the incident.
- A total of eight (8) damaged houses in Sta. Cruz, Davao del Sur.
- A total of 2 river dikes in Brgys. Cebulan and Astorga, Sta. Cruz, Davao del Sur were partially damaged.

**C. Actions Taken**
