STRONG TO GALE FORCE WINDS ARE EXPECTED TO AFFECT THE FOLLOWING AREAS:

SEABOARDS	WEATHER	WIND FORCE (KPH /KNOTS)	SEA CONDITION	WAVE HEIGHT (meters)
THE SEABOARDS OF NORTHERN LUZON AND THE WESTERN SEABOARDS OF CENTRAL AND SOUTHERN LUZON (Batanes, Babuyan Islands, Cagayan, Isabela, Ilocos Norte, Ilocos Sur, La Union, Pangasinan, Zambales, Bataan, and the western coast of Occidental Mindoro, and Palawan)	Occasional rains	41 - 63 / 22 – 34	Rough to very rough	2.5 to 4.5

You are hereby directed to still undertake precautionary measures and monitor the situation in your AOR. Likewise, the Public, and Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils (LDRRMCs) concerned are still advised to take precautions and appropriate actions.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate this advisory through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions.

Moreover, you are hereby directed to reiterate the guidelines on personal protection and hygiene such as respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene, social distancing, environmental, and food safety measures.
