### **PRESENT WEATHER:**

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, TROPICAL DEPRESSION DINDO WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 805 KM EAST OF TUGUEGARAO CITY, CAGAYAN (18.50°N, 129.30°E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 45 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 55 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTH NORTHWESTWARD AT 15 KM/H. SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING THE COUNTRY.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Moreover, you are hereby directed to reiterate the guidelines on personal protection and hygiene such as respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene, social distancing, environmental, and food safety measures.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
