PRESENT WEATHER:

SYNOPSIS: SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING LUZON. TROUGH OF LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) AFFECTING THE EASTERN SECTION OF MINDANAO. MEANWHILE, AT 3:00 PM TODAY, TROPICAL STORM "DINDO" (I.N. HAGUPIT) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 410 KM NORTHEAST OF BASCO, BATANES (23.2 °N, 124.6 °E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 85 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 105 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTHWESTWARD AT 15 KM/H.

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above-mentioned river systems and the **LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND MANAGEMENT COUNCILS** concerned are **advised to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides.**

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Moreover, you are hereby directed to reiterate the guidelines on personal protection and hygiene such as respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene, social distancing, environmental, and food safety measures.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
