PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 3:00 AM TODAY, SEVERE TROPICAL STORM "DINDO" (I.N. HAGUPIT) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 470 KM NORTH NORTHEAST OF BASCO, BATANES (24.3°N, 123.8°E) WITH MAXIMUM SUSTAINED WINDS OF 95 KM/H NEAR THE CENTER AND GUSTINESS OF UP TO 115 KM/H. IT IS MOVING NORTHWESTWARD AT 15 KM/H. MEANWHILE, A LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 570 KM EAST SOUTHEAST OF DAVAO CITY (5.9°N, 130.8°E). SOUTHWEST MONSOON AFFECTING NORTHERN AND CENTRAL LUZON.

DAVAO ORIENTAL - particularly Cateel, Dapnan, Baganga Mahan-Ub, Manorigao, Caraga, Casaunan, Quinonoan, Bagwan, Mayo, Bitanayan, Sumlog, Tangmoan, Dacongbonwa, Kabasagan, Manay, Maya, and Sumlao/Cuabo. DAVAO DEL SUR - particularly Davao, Talomo,

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Lipadas, Tagulaya Sibulan, Digos, and Padada Mainit.

No. 04 for Region XIII (CARAGA)

FORECAST 12-HR RAINFALL	LIGHT TO MODERATE RAINS
WATERCOURSES STILL LIKELY TO BE AFFECTED	 <u>Rivers and Tributaries in:</u> DINAGAT ISLANDS - particularly Malinao Inlet and Gaas Lulet. AGUSAN DEL SUR - particularly Ojot, Wawa, Libang, Maosam, Kasilan, Gibong, Adgaoan, Simulao, Kayonan, and Andanan. SURIGAO DEL NORTE - particularly Surigao and Magallanes. AGUSAN DEL NORTE - particularly Lake-Mainit-Tubay, Asiga, Agusan, Linugos, and Cabadbaran. SURIGAO DEL SUR - particularly Cantillan, Toracan, Tandag, Tago, Hubo-Oteiza, Hinatuan, and Bislig.

People living near the mountains slopes and in the low-lying areas of the abovementioned river systems and the <u>LOCAL DISASTER RISK REDUCTION AND</u> <u>MANAGEMENT COUNCILS</u> concerned are still advised to be alert for possible flashfloods.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Moreover, you are hereby directed to reiterate the guidelines on personal protection and hygiene such as respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene, social distancing, environmental, and food safety measures.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
