PRESENT WEATHER:

AT 10:00 AM TODAY, THE CENTER OF TROPICAL DEPRESSION "ENTENG" WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 420 KM EAST NORTHEAST OF CASIGURAN, AURORA OR 445 KM EAST OF TUGUEGARAO CITY, CAGAYAN (17.4 °N, 125.9 °E). MEANWHILE, A LOW PRESSURE AREA (LPA) WAS ESTIMATED BASED ON ALL AVAILABLE DATA AT 280 KM WEST OF SUBIC, ZAMBALES (14.6°N,117.7°E). THIS LPA IS LESS LIKELY TO DEVELOP INTO A TROPICAL DEPRESSION IN THE NEXT 24 HOURS .

Cruz, San Juan and San Cristobal. • BATANGAS – particularly Lian, Banabang-Molino, Pansipit, Kapumpong, Rosario-Lobo and Upper Bolbok (Liwaya). • RIZAL - particularly Upper Marikina and Kaliwa.

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People living near the mountains slopes and in the low-lying areas of the above-mentioned river systems and the Local Disaster Risk Reduction and Management Councils concerned are advised to take appropriate actions and to be alert for possible flashfloods and landslides.

In order to better inform/warn communities, you are reminded to disseminate these through local/community leaders and through your local media, including community radio stations. Conduct press briefings as often as needed. This local effort will complement and reinforce efforts at the national level. Emphasis should be on proactive actions – evacuation rather than rescue.

Moreover, you are hereby directed to reiterate the guidelines on personal protection and hygiene such as respiratory etiquette and hand hygiene, social distancing, environmental, and food safety measures.

Let's untiringly aim for zero casualty.
